If a public hearing is requested, the Executive Director will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, the SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

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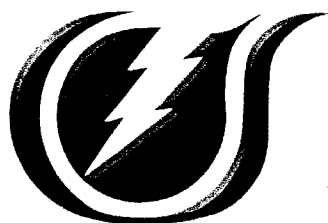

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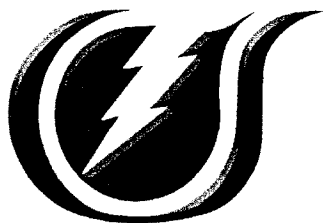

The purpose of this letter is to respond to your November 17, 2005 letter to me regarding the City of College Station's application to amend its sewer CCN. I received the letter on November 23, 2005 and it provides for a response deadline of November 25, 2005. The November 17, 2005 letter concludes that to date the TCEQ staff has not received information necessary to proceed with the City's application. As explained below, this conclusion is incorrect. Specifically you indicate that the following items are still needed:

- a) an original and three copies of a publisher's affidavit of the newspaper publication with tear sheets of the published notice attached;
- b) four copies of each individual notice and map sent to neighboring utilities and affected parties;
- c) one copy of the landowner notice and map sent to each landowner; and
- d) an original and three copies of the signed affidavits that individual notice to neighboring utilities, affected individuals and each landowner has been given.

The City of College Station transmitted these items to TCEQ via Federal Express for arrival on October 28, 2005. Federal Express records indicate the items were received by TCEQ on October 28, 2005 and that "L. Mercer" signed for the information.

I spoke with you on the telephone on November 2, 2005. You indicated that the TCEQ had indeed received the information on October 28, 2005 but that you had not received the packed through interoffice mail until November 1, 2005.

During the November 2, 2005 telephone conversation we also discussed an error in the acreage number that was sent to individual landowners. The acreage was corrected and new notice mailed to landowners on November 4, 2005. College Station will send to you today for delivery on Friday, November 25, 2005, the corrected landowner notice and affidavit.

Please confirm that TCEQ has indeed received the required information as you indicated to me on November 2, 2005. Alternatively, College Station asks for an extension of the November 25, 2005 deadline if TCEQ has not received all the required information so that the City can retransmit all the information to you.

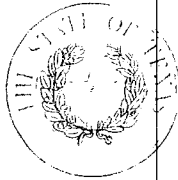

To date we have not received the required information necessary to proceed with the City of College Station's application.

As stated in our letter dated September 23, 2005, the next step towards having your application accepted is to provide the **revised** public notices without delay. The notice to the public must be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in Brazos County. It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide correct notice of the application to any utilities within two (2) miles of your proposed service area, any city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction which overlaps the proposed service area or other affected parties in your requested area. You will also be required to provide mailed notice to all landowners included in your proposed CCN area pursuant to commission order dated October 21, 2004. The landowner information may be obtained from the county appraisal district tax rolls for the county or counties in which the proposed CCN lies. Check the notices carefully before mailing or publishing.

As proof that notice was provided, you are required to send us the following:

- a) an original and three copies of a publisher's affidavit of the newspaper publication with tear sheets of the published notice attached;
- b) four copies of each individual notice and map sent to neighboring utilities and affected parties;
- c) one copy of the landowner notice and map sent to each landowner; and
- d) an original and three copies of the signed affidavits that individual notice to neighboring utilities, affected individuals and each landowner has been given. (Copies of the Affidavit forms are enclosed with this letter.)

In addition to the notice requirements the following information is also necessary to proceed with your application:

- a) Provide copies of any additional letters of intent from developers, landowner requests, applications for service or a combination of the above to justify the need for sewer service in the requested area.
- b) Your application has received a preliminary review of your financial and managerial capability to provide service to the requested area. Please provide a copy of your September 30, 2004 fiscal year-end audit. You may be asked for additional information after a comprehensive review.
- c) You will also be required to provide landowners consent for all proposed area located outside the City of College Station's current extraterritorial jurisdiction.

These items must be completed and returned by **November 25, 2005**. Processing of this application cannot proceed until the close of the 30 day public comment period which begins after all the required notices have been given. If we do not receive the requested information by this date, your application will be returned for failure to prosecute.

If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

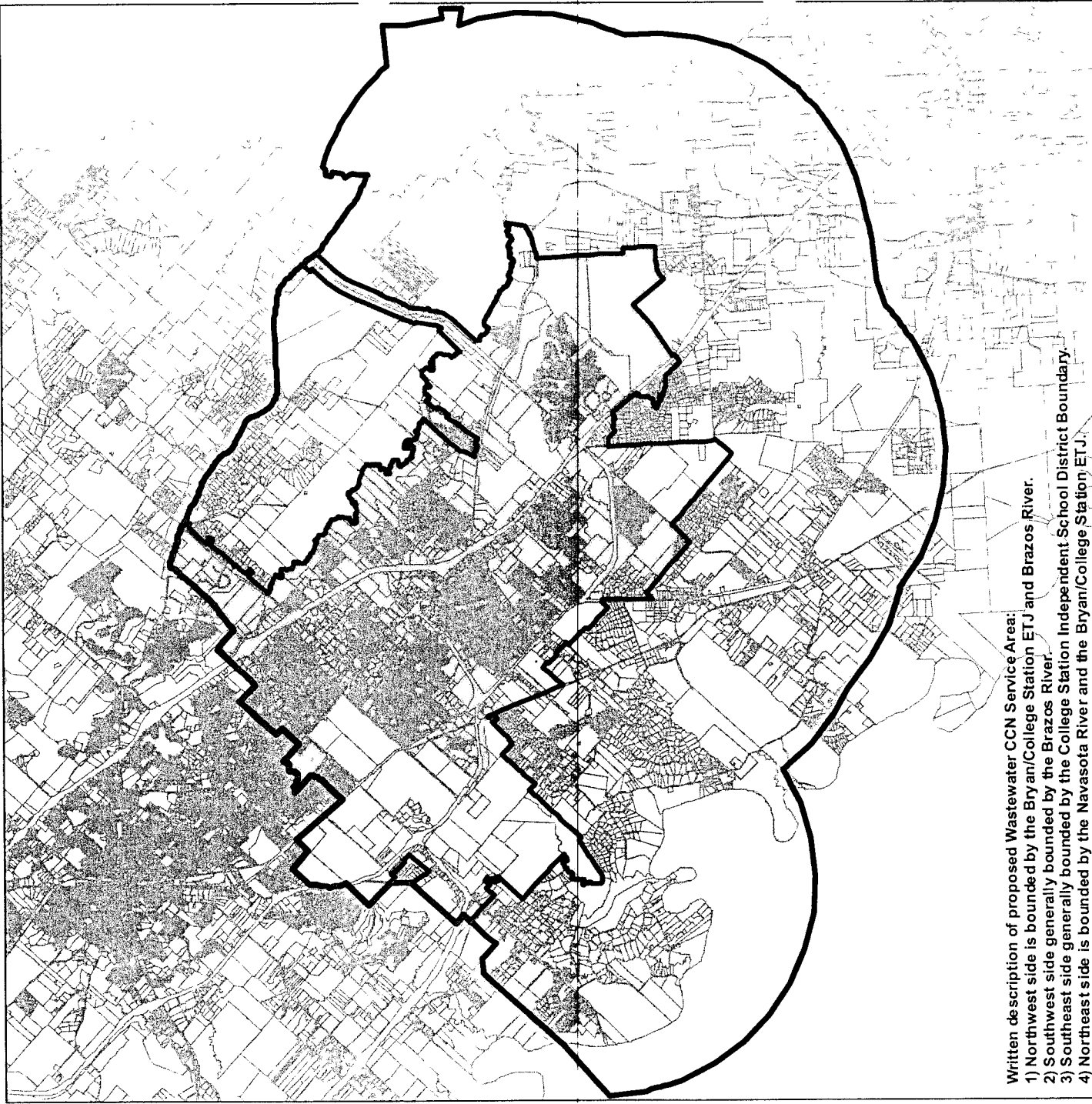

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

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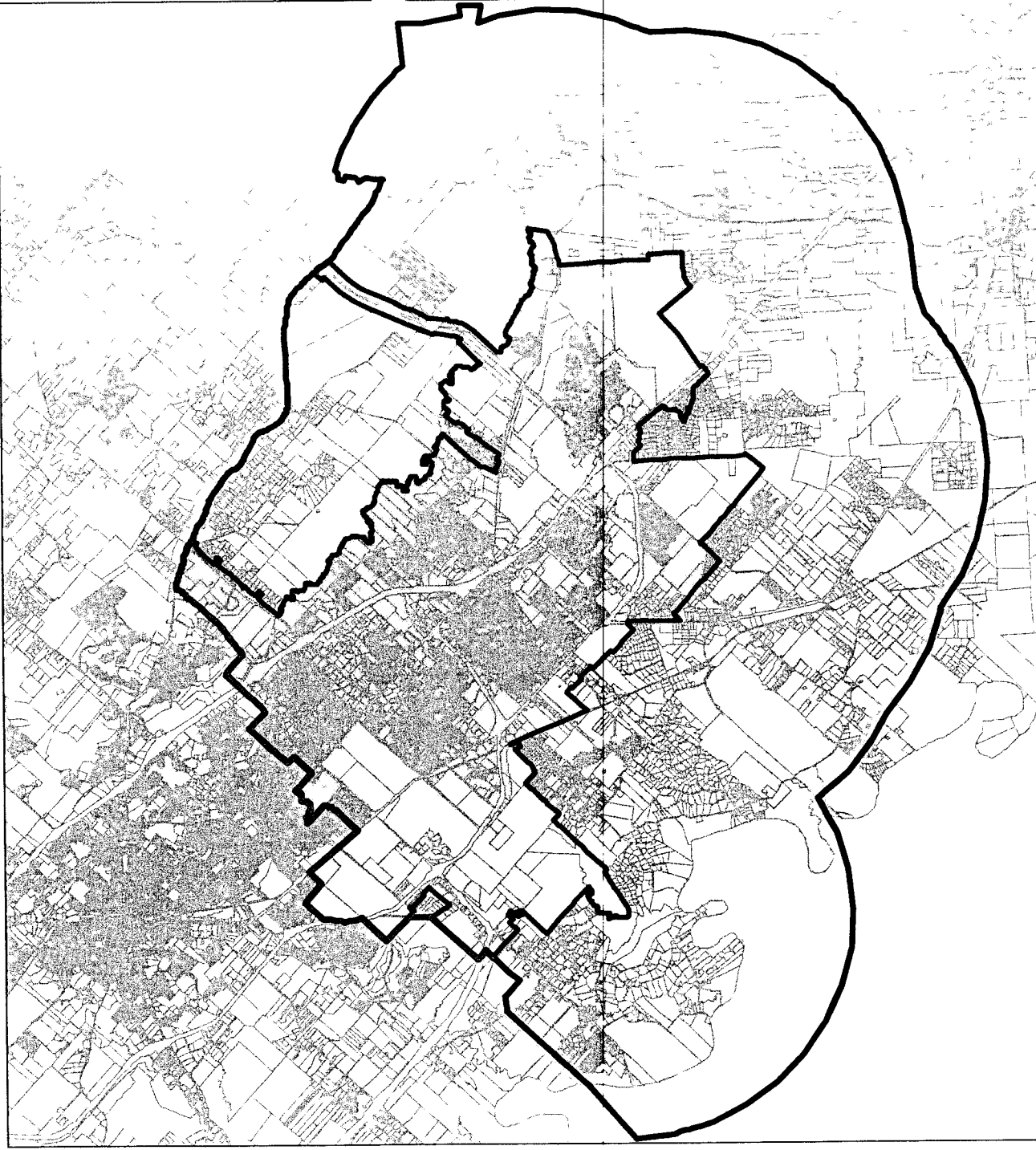
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
