

MONARCH UTILITIES I, L.P.'S PETITION FOR REVIEW OF MUNICIPAL RATE ORDINANCE AND MOTION FOR INTERIM RATES

Monarch Utilities I, L.P. ("Monarch" or "Company") hereby appeals the rate decision of the City of Ivanhoe ("Ivanhoe") denying Monarch's Application for a Rate/Tariff Change and changing Monarch's existing rates. Monarch also requests interim rates for customers inside the City of Ivanhoe. This appeal of Ivanhoe's rate ordinance and motion for interim rates is filed pursuant to Sections 13.043 and 13.187 of the Texas Water Code.

I. Monarch's Pending Rate Change Applications

On September 3, 2013, Monarch filed an Application for a water and sewer Rate/Tariff Change with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("TCEQ" or "Commission") to increase rates in areas over which the TCEQ has original jurisdiction. The application was assigned Application Nos. 37714-R and 37715-R. On September 3, 2013, Monarch also filed applications in cities with original jurisdiction over Monarch's rates within their city limits, including the City of Ivanhoe.

II. TCEQ Jurisdiction

The Commission has exclusive appellate jurisdiction over this appeal of an ordinance and decision of a municipality pursuant to Texas Water Code §§ 13.042 and 13.043. The Commission has the authority to set interim rates during the pendency of a rate case pursuant to Texas Water Code § 13.187.

III. Appeal of City of Ivanhoe's Ordinance Denying the Application and Setting New Rates

The City Council for the City of Ivanhoe suspended the effective date for the implementation of Monarch's rate increase on September 12, 2013 in City of Ivanhoe Resolution #2013-8R. Subsequently, the City Council for the City of Ivanhoe passed Ordinance #2013-8, denying Monarch's application and changing Monarch's existing rates on December 28, 2013. In its ordinance, the City decreased some of Monarch's rates and increased others (the "New Rates"). Monarch hereby appeals that ordinance (action). Monarch received notice of the City's action on December 28, 2013 via fax, a copy of which is included as Attachment A. This appeal is timely filed within 90 days of receipt of that notice.¹

IV. Motion for Interim Rates

During the pendency of a rate proceeding, the TCEQ has the authority to set interim rates under Texas Water Code. § 13.187. Pursuant to 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 291.29(d), interim rates may be established in cases where "the proposed increase in rates could result in an unreasonable economic hardship on the utility's customers, unjust or unreasonable rates, or failure to set interim rates could result in an unreasonable economic hardship on the utility." Monarch requests that the TCEQ set interim rates at the level prior to the City's action, which are the rates that were approved by the City Council in a settlement agreement in Monarch's last rate case ("Settlement Rates"). The relevant portion of the tariffs for the Settlement Rates for customers inside the City of Ivanhoe are included as Attachment B.


In City of Ivanhoe Ordinance #2012-6, the City Council of the City of Ivanhoe adopted the Settlement Agreement reached in TCEQ Docket No. 2011-1280-UCR (Attachment C). In passing the Ordinance that is the subject of this appeal, the City of Ivanhoe has changed rates

Tex. Water Code § 13.043(a).

effective on all meter reads after January 31, 2014. Although the Ordinance reduces the customer charge, the Ordinance increases the rates for the gallonage tiers for 2,000 to 10,000 gallons from \$7.45 to \$9.08, 10,000 to 20,0000 gallons from \$8.45 to \$13.61, and over 20,000 gallons from \$9.00 to \$20.42.

As a result, of these increased charges in the higher usage tiers, customers that are larger users will actually be paying higher rates than they were paying under the Settlement Rates agreed upon by Ivanhoe in May 2012. Residential customers using more than approximately 9,100 gallons per month will pay more as a result of the higher rates being imposed on the higher tiers. The table below depicts the difference in monthly bills for various usage levels between the rates set by Ivanhoe and the Settlement Rates for residential customers.

DIFFERENCE BETWEEN SETTLEMENT AND NEW RATES - RESIDENTIAL



Also, these lower rates will subject almost all customers to a greater impact in the future because of the size of the potential surcharge after a final decision by the TCEQ. If the TCEQ grants Monarch's rate increase dating back to the February 1, 2014 effective date of the City's reduced rates, customers will face a surcharge not only for the difference between the TCEQ approved rates and Monarch's Settlement Rates, but also for the additional amount the City reduced rates below the Settlement Rates. This additional harm to the customers can be avoided by setting interim rates at the Settlement Rates.

The rate change imposed by the City of Ivanhoe places an unreasonable hardship on Monarch's customers that should be avoided and could result in unjust and unreasonable rates for those customers well in excess of the Settlement Rates and unreasonable hardship on all other customers facing larger surcharges. The City of Ivanhoe's rates are unreasonably preferential and prejudicial and violate Texas Water Code. § 13.189. Therefore, Monarch requests that interim rates be set at Monarch's rates prior to the City of Ivanhoe's action, the Settlement Rates with an effective date of February 1, 2014. Monarch requests a surcharge or bill credit for each customer account since the effective date.

V. Prayer

Monarch respectfully requests that the Commission enter an order granting Monarch's petition for review and setting interim rates. Additionally, Monarch respectfully requests that upon final hearing, Monarch be granted the rate relief as requested in its Application. Monarch also requests any such further relief to which it may be entitled.

ATTACHMENT A WHEREAS, municipal water and wastewater utilities, electric utilities, and gas utilities impose much lower monthly base or customer charges than what is levied by Monarch; and

WHEREAS, the current volumetric rates need to be adjusted to properly encourage conservation and the efficient use of water; and

WHEREAS, the relationship between a fixed monthly rate (base or customer charge) and volumetric rates is a matter of public policy well within the decision-making authority of the City Council.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF IVANHOE, TEXAS THAT:

- Section 1. The findings set out in the preamble are in all things approved and incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
- Section 2. The Statement of Intent filed by Monarch with the City Secretary on or about September 5, 2015 to change rates/tariffs is in all respects REJECTED and DENIED.
- Section 3. The monthly minimum fixed charge for a typical water customer located within the City of Ivanhoe is reduced as shown on Attachment A.
- Section 4. For customers using 5,000 gallons of water, the monthly rate is reduced by 8.99% for water, consistent with the policy goals of encouraging conservation and reducing the onerous rates imposed on customers of modest means.
- Section 5. The proposed rates on Attachments A are the new rates adopted by this ordinance. The new rates for water will be effective on all meter reads after January 31, 2014.
- Section 6. Monarch shall file tariffs with the City Secretary consistent with this ordinance no later than the 16th day of January 2014.

Section 7. A copy of this ordinance shall be sent by the City Secretary to Mr. Chuck Profilet, President of Monarch Utilities I, L.P., 12535 Reed Road, Sugar Land, Texas 77478 by Federal Express and by fax to Mr. George Freitag, Rate/Regulatory Manager, Monarch Utilities I, L.P., at 281.207.5940.

Section 8. Notice was duly given pursuant to the Texas Public Information Act with regard to the subjects of this ordinance.

ORDINANCE #2012-6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF IVANHOE, TEXAS; AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF A SETTLEMENT OF THE APPLICATION FOR AN INCREASE IN WATER AND SEWER RATES BY MONARCH UTILITIES I, L.P. NEGOTIATED BY REPRESENATIVES OF THE COALITION OF CITIES, (INCLUDING THE CITIES OF BLUE MOUND, BUDA, IVANHOE AND KYLE), TAMER (ON BEHALF OF ENVIRONS CUSTOMERS), THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE TEXAS COMMISSION OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY, MONARCH UTILITIES I, L.P., AND OTHER PARITES WHO ARE EXPECTED TO JOIN IN ADOPTING THE PROPOSED SETTLEMENT; DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED COMPLIED WITH THE TEXAS OPEN MEETINGS ACT; MAKING SUCH OTHER FINDINGS AND PROVISIONS RELATED TO THE SUBJECT; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on November 10, 2011 Monarch Utilities I, L.P. ("Monarch") filed a Statement of Intent with the City Secretary for the City of Ivanhoe, Texas ("City") to increase water rates on a system-wide basis by 62.3%; and

WHEREAS, the settlement increases the revenue requirement on a system-wide basis by approximately 8.7% on June 1, 2012 and by approximately 4% on, January 1, 2013, but increases for many customers will involve much smaller increases due to an inverted rate design aimed at encouraging conservation; and

WHEREAS, for the first time since Monarch begin providing water service the base rate or minimum monthly charge will decrease for residential customers from the current monthly rate and customers using a small amount of water, 2000 gallons, will experience almost no increase in cost; and

WHEREAS, the settlement involves very substantial reductions for residential customers from the water rates requested by Monarch, for consumption after June 1, 2012 (phase 1), as follows:

WHEREAS, for consumption after June 1, 2013 (phase 2), the decreases from the requested amounts are slightly smaller, except that the base charge remains the same, as follows:

WHEREAS, unlike most water rate proceedings, the settlement provides that no rate case expenses be borne by ratepayers.

WHEREAS, the settlement provides for a moratorium on any additional rate increases before January 1, 2014 except for purchased water adjustments but the Coalition of Cities will be given notice of any such adjustments filed at the TCEQ; and

WHEREAS, the settlement provides that Monarch shall not request a valuation of its invested capital or seek to set depreciation rates at the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality before the next general rate case; and

WHEREAS, the rate increase for sewer service was also a part of the settlement with Monarch, resulting in no overall increase in rates for sewer customers.

WHEREAS, Monarch withdrew its request to acquire seven stand-alone water utilities and three sewer utilities which would have caused ratepayers inside the City to subsidize many of the stand-alone utilities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF IVANHOE, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1. The facts contained in the Preamble of this Ordinance are determined to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. The settlement, attached hereto as Appendix A, with an addendum, is hereby adopted and approved.

Section 3. Special Counsel, Herrera & Boyle, PLLP, for the City of Ivanhoe, is instructed to do all things consistent with promoting the adoption of the settlement by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

Section 4. A copy of this ordinance will be sent to Mr. George Freitag, Rate Manager, Monarch Utilities I, L.P., 12535 Reed Road, Sugar Land, Texas 77478 and to Mr. Jim Boyle, Herrera & Boyle, PLLP, 816 Congress, Suite 1250, Austin, Texas 78701.

Section 5. The meeting at which this resolution was approved was in all things conducted in strict compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551.

Section 6 This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage.
