We received the notice documents for the above referenced application on December 15, 2003. To further process this application we need following information:


1. A signed copy of the inter-local agreement between Brazos River Authority, Lower Colorado River Authority and the City of Liberty Hill;







Dear Mr. Basnet:

I am sending you this letter in response to your January 7, 2004 Notice of Deficiency. You request that we provide you three items: (1) the interlocal agreement between the Brazos River Authority, the Lower Colorado River Authority, and the City of Liberty Hill; (2) written documentation from Chisholm Trail SUD consenting to the application; and (3) a copy of the signed agreement with Williamson County MUD #13.

As for the interlocal agreement, currently, the three entities are finalizing two agreements: the Interlocal Agreement Regarding BRA-LCRA Alliance Liberty Hill Wastewater Systems and the Wastewater Services Agreement between BRA-LCRA Alliance and the City of Liberty Hill. I have included drafts of the each of these agreements for your review. The parties anticipate finalizing the agreements by March 1, 2004. We will provide you copies of the final, signed agreements as soon as they are completed.

As for written documentation from Chisholm Trail SUD ("Chisholm") and Williamson County MUD #13 ("MUD #13") evidencing these entities' consent to the CCN Application of the Brazos River Authority, the Lower Colorado River Authority, and the City of Liberty Hill (the "Applicants"), such consent is not required from Chisholm or MUD #13. Section 13.244 of the Texas Water Code requires that an applicant provide to the Commission evidence it has received the "required consent, franchise, or permit of the proper municipality or other public authority." TEX.


WATER CODE ANN. § 13.244 (Vernon 2000) (Emphasis added). A municipal utility district and special utility districts have only the authority granted to them by the Texas Legislature in Chapter 49 (relating to all districts), Chapter 54 (relating to MUDs), and Chapter 65 (relating to SUDs) of the Texas Water Code. Additionally, MUD #13 is governed by its enabling legislation (78th Leg., R.S., ch. 760, 2003 Tex. Gen. Law 2204).

None of these governing statutes provide authority to Chisholm or MUD #13 to require the Applicants to obtain consent, a franchise, or a permit from Chisholm or MUD #13. Moreover, the mere fact that Chisholm and MUD #13 have the authority to provide water and wastewater service within their respective districts does not give these entities authority to require consent from the Applicants to provide wastewater service in the area requested by the Application. It should be noted that the Applicants also have authority to provide wastewater service in the area. *See* TEX. WATER CODE ANN. Chapters 221 and 222 (Vernon 2004); TEX. LOCAL GOV'T CODE § 402.001 (Vernon 1999).

Nevertheless, the Lower Colorado River Authority is currently negotiating agreements with both Chisholm and MUD #13 regarding wastewater service. These agreements, however, have not been finalized. The Applicants request that the Commission move forward on its review of the Application without these agreements. The Applicants will provided copies of the agreements to the Commission as soon as they are finalized.

**WASTEWATER SERVICES AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN BRA – LCRA ALLIANCE  
AND CITY OF LIBERTY HILL**

**THIS AGREEMENT** ("Agreement") is made and entered into this the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2004, by and between the **CITY OF LIBERTY HILL, TEXAS** ("City"), the **BRAZOS RIVER AUTHORITY ("BRA")**, and the **LOWER COLORADO RIVER AUTHORITY ("LCRA")**.

**RECITALS**

WHEREAS, the City is a general law municipality organized under the Texas Local Government Code with full power and authority to provide wastewater utility services to residents of the City and to certain areas within the extraterritorial jurisdiction ("ETJ") of the City that may ultimately be annexed by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to have the BRA-LCRA Alliance ("Alliance") provide retail wastewater collection and treatment service to customers within the City's corporate limits and certain portions of the City's ETJ;

WHEREAS, the parties to the Alliance desire to provide retail and wholesale wastewater collection and treatment services through the construction or acquisition of necessary facilities by the LCRA and the operation of those facilities by the BRA;

WHEREAS, the City, BRA, and LCRA desire to enter into an interlocal agreement, in accordance with the terms and provisions of the Interlocal Cooperation Act of the Texas Government Code as applicable to contracts for wastewater systems and services (Tex. Gov't Code Ann. § 791.026), and furthermore pursuant to authorities granted in chapters 30 and 49 of the Texas Water Code, chapter 402 of the Texas Local Government Code, and other laws and regulations; and

We are very concerned that sewage will spill directly onto our property if the treatment plant is located at the design location. The drainage ditch is ideal located for their sewage to overflow and accidental spillage into our river onto my back yard. This drainage ditch to dispose of over flow, is probably a large reason in choosing this location.

If additional hearings and meetings are required please advise so we may publicly voice our concerns.
