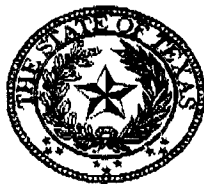

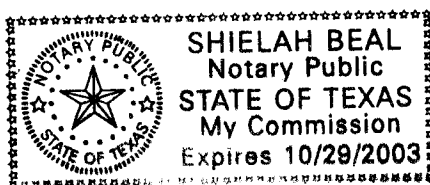


**ORDER NO. 1  
GRANTING MOTION TO CONTINUE PRELIMINARY HEARING**

On November 21, 2002, Wollaston Properties, L.L.C. d/b/a Whitewater Springs Water System (Applicant) moved to continue the currently scheduled December 10, 2002, preliminary hearing until the week of March 24, 2003. It represents that it hopes to reach an agreement by which the Lower Colorado River Authority (LCRA) will acquire and operate the water system. If that occurs, the Applicant will withdraw its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) application in this case. The Executive Director (ED), the Public Interest Counsel (PIC), and the majority of the Protestants—those represented by attorney Richard Jacobs—support the motion.

The motion is granted. The preliminary hearing is rescheduled for 10:00 a.m., March 24, 2003, at the William P. Clements Office Building, Fourth Floor, 300 West 15th Street, Austin, Texas.

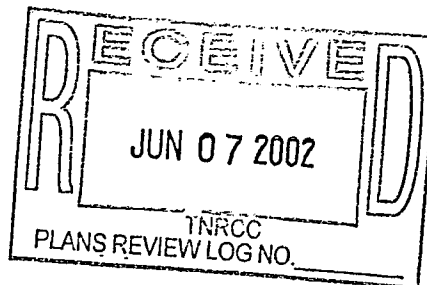
Dear Mr. Adhikari,

I just got word from our Engineering Company that the HomeOwners are disputing the rates we want to set here at Whitewater Springs. When we sent out the letter we asked for \$30.00 for the first 2,000 gallons and \$4.00 for every 1,000 after that, \$750.00 for a tap fee. Since we sent this letter out and because I heard the owners were disputing this matter, I spent 2-3 hours at the TNRCC getting all the surrounding areas dues on private water systems. What I found was that our \$30.00 for 2,000 gallons was not excessive, I also found that the \$4.00 per 1,000 after that first 2,000 gallons was a little high. We sent a letter out to all Homeowners saying we wanted to keep it at \$30.00 for the first 2,000 gallons and that we would drop our \$4.00 for every 1,000 after that to \$2.00 for every 1,000 after which is the average for similar private water systems. We are located several miles outside of town, therefore costs are a little higher such as delivery charges, supplies, etc. We never heard anything from any of the homeowners, I've heard we have to get everyone to agree to this change and I don't think that will happen, so I would like to take this to the next level whatever it may be. We feel our rates are fair considering what surrounding areas are charging, also to address some other issues, they are saying that they want another well and the TNRCC says we can't get one until the system has been totally approved. The construction part of the system has been approved so all we need to do is to figure out a few small things like this and we will be totally approved. I've sent copies of surrounding areas water system rates so that you may see what we are asking for is not excessive or unfair, also enclosed is a copy of the WWS approval information for the systems construction for Whitewater Springs.

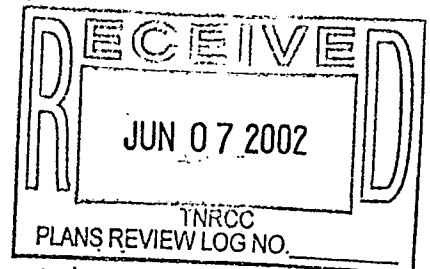

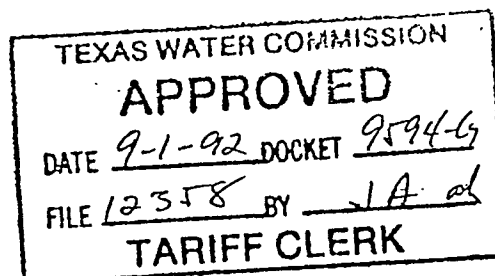

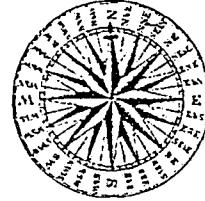

**SECTION G.**  
**RATES AND SERVICE FEES**

Unless specifically defined in this Tariff, all fees, rates, and charges as stated shall be non-refundable.

1. ***Service Investigation Fee.*** The Corporation shall conduct a service investigation for each service application submitted at the Corporation office. An initial determination shall be made by the Corporation, without charge, as to whether the service request is Standard or Non-Standard. An investigation shall then be conducted and the results reported under the following terms:
  - a. All Standard Service requests shall be investigated without charge and all applicable costs for providing service shall be quoted in writing to the Applicant within ten (10) working days of application.
  - b. All Non-Standard Service requests shall be subject to a fee, appropriate to each project, of sufficient amount to cover all administrative, legal, and engineering fees associated with investigation of the Corporation's ability to deliver service to the Applicant to:
    - (1) provide cost estimates of the project,
    - (2) present detailed plans and specifications as per final plat,
    - (3) advertise and accept bids for the project,
    - (4) present a Non-Standard Service Contract to the Applicant, and
    - (5) provide other services as required by the Corporation for such investigation.A Non-Standard Service Contract shall be presented to the Applicant within a suitable amount of time as determined by the complexity of the project. (See Section F.)
2. ***Membership Fee.*** At the time the application for service is approved, a refundable Membership Fee must be paid before service shall be provided or reserved for the Applicant by the Corporation.
  - a. The Membership Fee for water service is \$ 350.00 for each service unit.
  - b. The Membership Fee for wastewater service is \$ 350.00 for each service unit.
3. ***Easement Fee.*** When the Corporation determines that private right-of-way easements and/or facility sites are necessary to provide service to the Applicant, the Applicant shall be required to make good faith efforts to secure easements on behalf of the Corporation and/or pay all costs incurred by the Corporation in validating, clearing, and retaining such right-of-way in addition to tap fees otherwise required pursuant to the provisions of this Tariff. The costs may include all legal fees and expenses necessary to attempt to secure such right-of-way and/or facilities sites on behalf of the Applicant. (see Section E.2.c.(2), Section F.7.a.)
4. ***Installation Fee (Tap Fee)*** . The Corporation shall charge an installation fee for service as follows:
  - a. **Standard Service** shall include all current labor, materials, engineering, legal, customer service inspection, and administrative costs necessary to provide individual metered water or wastewater service and shall be charged on a per tap basis. The Tap Fee for water is \$750 and the Tap Fee for sewer is \$750.
  - b. **Non-Standard Service** shall include any and all construction labor and materials, inspection, administration, legal, and engineering fees, as determined by the

- b. **Reserved Service Charges (Standby Fees)** -- The monthly charge for each active account at a specific location for which a meter has not been installed but for which the Corporation and the Applicant have entered into agreement and/or contract for reserved service. This monthly charge shall be based on the Corporation's fixed costs to service the Applicant's dedicated facilities on a per-service-unit basis. This charge reserves service to the Applicant's real estate designated to receive service. The Standby Fee is \$13 per month for water and \$13 per month for sewer; or if standby fees are paid in a lump sum at the beginning of the year, the Standby Fee for water is \$108 for the year and the Standby Fee for sewer is \$108 for the year.
- c. **Gallage Charge** - In addition to the Service Availability Charge, a gallage charge shall be added at the following rates for usage during any one (1) billing period.

- (1) Water - \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons for any gallage over 3,000 gallons, up to 5,000 gallons; and \$4.00 per 1,000 gallons for any gallage over 5,000 gallons.
- (2) Sewer - \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons of water for any gallage over 3,000 gallons, up to 5,000 gallons; and \$4.00 per 1,000 gallons of water for any gallage over 5,000 gallons.

Corporation under the rules of Section F of this Tariff.

- c. Standard and Non-Standard Service Installations shall include all costs of pipeline relocations as per Section E.I.c.(6) of this Tariff.

5. **Equity Buy-In Fee.** In addition to the Membership Fee, each Applicant shall be required to achieve parity with existing Members by contributing capital in an amount projected to defray the cost of up-grading system facilities to meet growth demands created by adding customers. This fee shall be assessed immediately prior to providing or reserving service on a per-service-unit basis for each tap/lot and shall be assigned and restricted to the tap/lot for which the service was originally requested and will be based on actual cost.

6. **Monthly Charges.**

a. **Service Availability Charge**

- (1) **Water Service** - The monthly charge for metered water service, which may or may not include allowable gallonage, is based on demand by meter size. Each charge is assessed based on the number of 5/8" X 3/4" meters (as per American Water Works Association maximum continuous flow specifications) (see Miscellaneous) equivalent to the size indicated and is used as a base multiplier for the Service Availability Charge and allowable gallonage. Rates and equivalents are as follows:

- (3) The Corporation shall, as required by Section 5.235, Water Code of the State of Texas, collect from each of its retail customers a regulatory assessment equal to one-half of one percent of the charge for retail water or wastewater service. This charge shall be collected in addition to other charges for utility service. This fee is collected on all charges pertaining to Section G.6., Monthly Charges of this tariff. (30 TAC 291.76d.(3)(l))
7. **Late Payment Fee.** Once per billing period, a penalty of \$1.00 or 5%, whichever is larger, shall be applied to delinquent bills. This late payment penalty shall not be applied to any balance to which the penalty was applied in a previous billing, but shall be applied to any unpaid balance during the current billing period.
8. **Owner Notification Fee.** The Corporation may, at the expense of the Member, notify said Member of a renter/lessee delinquent account status prior to disconnection of service. The Owner Notification Fee shall be \$ 20.00 per notification. (See Miscellaneous Transaction Forms.)
9. **Mortgagee/Guarantor Notification Fee.** The Corporation shall assess a fee of \$20.00 for each notification to a Membership lien-holder under agreement prior to Membership cancellation. (See Miscellaneous Transaction Forms.)
10. **Returned Check Fee.** In the event a check, draft, or any other similar instrument is given by a person, firm, corporation, or partnership to the Corporation for payment of services provided for in this Tariff, and the instrument is returned by the bank or other similar institution as insufficient or non-negotiable for any reason, the account for which the instrument was issued shall be assessed a return check charge of \$25.00. (see Miscellaneous Transaction Forms)
11. **Reconnect Fee.** The Corporation shall charge a fee of \$35.00 for reconnecting service after the Corporation has previously disconnected the service for any reason provided for in this Tariff except for activation of service. under Section E.3.b., Re-Service.
12. **Service Trip Fee.** The Corporation shall charge a trip fee of \$ 30.00 for any service call or trip to the Member's tap as a result of a request by the Member or resident (unless the service call is in response to damage of the Corporation's or another Member's facilities) or for the purpose of disconnecting or collecting payment for services.
13. **Equipment Damage Fee.** If the Corporation's facilities or equipment have been damaged by tampering, by-passing, installing unauthorized taps, reconnecting service without authority, or other service diversion, a fee shall be charged equal to the actual costs for all labor, material, and equipment necessary for repair, replacement, and other Corporation actions. This fee shall be charged and paid before service is re-established. If the Corporation's equipment has not been damaged, a fee equal to the actual costs for all labor, material, equipment, and other actions necessary to correct service diversions, unauthorized taps, or reconnection of service without authority shall be charged. All components of this fee will be itemized, and a statement shall be provided to the Member. If the Corporation's facilities or equipment have been damaged due to negligence or unauthorized use of the Corporation's equipment, right-of-way, or meter shut-off valve, or due to other acts for which

the Corporation incurs losses or damages, the Member shall be liable for all labor and material charges incurred as a result of said acts or negligence.

14. **Customer History Report Fee.** A fee of \$ 15.00 may be charged to provide a copy of the Member's record of past water purchases in response to a Member's request for such a record.
15. **Meter Test Fee.** The Corporation shall test a Member's meter upon written request of the Member. Under the terms of Section E of this Tariff, a charge of \$ 20.00 shall be imposed on the affected account.
16. **Transfer Fee.** An Applicant for service who is a Transferee shall complete all required application forms, etc., and pay a Transfer Fee of \$ 35.00.
17. **Membership Certificate Copy Fee.** A fee of \$ 10.00 will be charged to provide a duplicate copy of the Membership Certificate.
18. **Non-Disclosure Fee.** A fee of \$5.00 shall be assessed any customer requesting in writing that personal information under the terms of this tariff not be disclosed to the public.
19. **Information Disclosure Fee.** All public information except that which has been individually requested as confidential shall be available to the public for a fee to be determined by the Corporation based on the level of service and costs to provide such information, but not to be inconsistent with the terms of the Texas Open Records Act, Chapter 552, Texas Local Government Code.
20. **Other Fees.** All services outside the normal scope of utility operations which the Corporation may be compelled to provide at the request of a customer or Member shall be charged to the recipient based on the cost of providing such service.

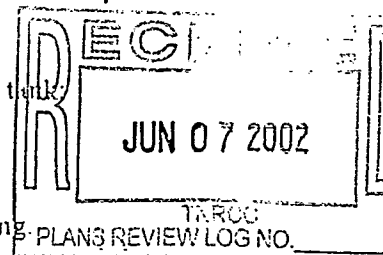

The planning material received on March 20, 2002, with your letter dated March 18, 2002 for the as-built water system improvements has been reviewed. The project generally meets the minimum requirements of the TNRCC's Chapter §290 - Rules and Regulations for Public Water Systems (Rules) and is approved.

The submittal consisted of 24 sheets of engineering drawings and technical specifications. The approved project consists of the following:

- Construction of one water supply well to a depth of 500 feet, with 500 linear feet of 6-inch i.d. steel casing, pressure cemented to a depth of 420 feet. A pump test indicated a yield of approximately 40 g.p.m.;
- Construction of a 100,800-gallon AWWA D103 bolted-steel ground storage tank;
- Installation of one 4,120-gallon hydropneumatic tank;
- Construction of a 12-ft by 20-ft concrete masonry unit pump/chlorine building;



The TNRCC does not approve this well for use as a public water supply at this time. We have enclosed a copy of the "Public Well Completion Data Checklist for Interim Approval." We provide this checklist to help you in obtaining interim approval to use this well before we can give final approval.

The well and treatment plant are located on Lot No. 238 in the northwest side of Section 2 of the Whitewater Springs development, in Burnet County, Texas.





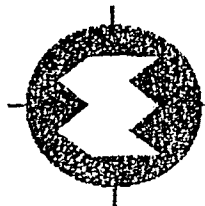

Enclosed, for your review and approval are the following items listed in TNRCC's "Public Well Completion Data Checklist for Interim Approval" for the well for the Whitewater Springs Water System:

- Sanitary control easement filed with the Burnet County Clerk.
- Construction Data on the well is provided on the enclosed copy of the well driller's State of Texas Well Report. A summary of the data is provided below:
  - Casing size = 6-5/8 inch
  - Bore hole diameter = 10 inch
  - Total well depth = 500 ft
  - Casing material = Steel
  - Casing length = 420 ft. Joe McDearmon, of Hill Country Water Well, stated during a phone conversation that the well is cased to 420 ft with a 60 ft screen.
  - Cementing depth = 0 to 420 ft
  - Cementing method = pressure cemented from the bottom up to the top of the well
  - The well driller's geologic log is provided on the enclosed well driller's State of Texas Well Report
- Copy of USGS 7.5 minute topographic map showing the location of the well
- Hill Country Water Well performed the 36-hour pump test on the well. A letter from Mr. Joe E. McDearmon, of Hill Country Water Well, is enclosed stating that the 36-hour pump test has been performed. The well's rated capacity is listed on the well driller's log to be 40 gpm with a static water level at 300 ft. According to Mr. McDearmon's letter, the pump is placed at 400 ft.



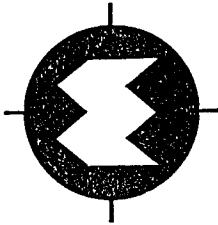

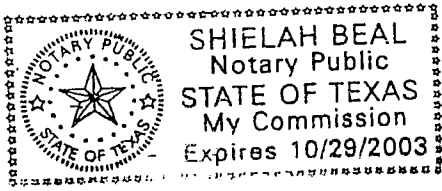
