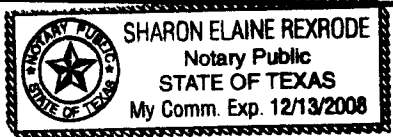

The City of Ovilla has filed applications for a

decertify portions of the City of Glenn Heights with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to provide water & sewer utility service in Dallas and Ellis Counties.

The proposed utility service area is located approximately 1 mile east and 1 mile north of downtown Ovilla, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Bear Creek Road; on the east by Hampton Road; and on the south by Red Oak Creek Road; and on the west by Cockrell Hill Road.

The total area being requested includes approximately 500 acres and 89 current customers.

A request for a public hearing must be in writing. You must state (1) your name, mailing address, and daytime telephone number; (2) the applicant's name, application number or another recognizable

reference to this application; (3) the statement "I/we request a public hearing"; (4) a brief description of how you or the persons you represent, would be adversely affected by the granting of the application for a CCN; (5) your proposed adjustment to the application or CCN which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing. Persons who wish to intervene or comment should write the

within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication or notice. A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a

written hearing request or a written request to be notified if a hearing is set will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.

If a public hearing is requested, the Executive Director will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an

evidentiary hearing is held, the SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

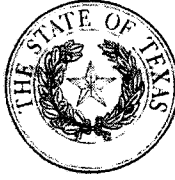
