The City of Ovilla has filed an application to amend CCN No. 11459 and to decertify portions of the City of Glenn Heights with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to provide water and sewer utility service in Dallas and Ellis Counties.

The proposed utility service area is located approximately one mile east of downtown Ovilla, Texas and is generally bounded on the north by Little Creek; on the east by Little Creek; on the south by Red Oak Creek Road; and the west by Westmoreland Road. within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication or notice. A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission o nits own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request or a written request to be notified if a hearing is set will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.

If a public hearing is requested, the Executive Director will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, the SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for a final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.
