The City of Ovilla applies to amend water and obtain sewer CCNs, and decertify a portion of existing water and sewer CCNs of the City of Glenn Heights. The area is represented by Ovilla to be within their city limits. The area contains a total of 500 acres and 89 current customers. Their water system has 1,223 connections.

I have reviewed the system's audit for the fiscal year ended September 30, 2004. It shows business-type activities (utility) total assets of \$10,218,401, non-current liabilities of \$1,184,952, and net assets of \$8,662.285, for a debt-to-equity ratio of just .14:1. The debt--service-coverage-ratio was 1.38:1. Required annual principal and interest payments for business-type activities for 2005 are \$118,214 and for 2006 are \$115,583. No additional projections were required.

In my opinion, this applicant has demonstrated adequate financial and managerial capability to provide service to the requested area. These conclusions are based on information provided by the applicant prior to this date and may not reflect any changes in the applicant's status subsequent to this date.
