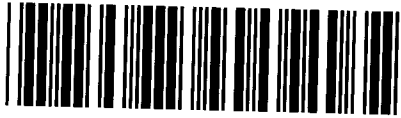

STAFF'S REQUEST FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this request for a Supplemental Procedural Schedule. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On January 13, 2015, Double Diamond d/b/a The Cliffs Resort (Double Diamond) filed an application to amend its water and sewer certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Palo Pinto County, Texas. Double Diamond seeks to amend its CCNs to include an area developed subsequent to the original development and where services are already provided.

On January 8, 2016, Order No. 8 was issued, requiring Staff to file a final recommendation or a supplemental procedural schedule by February 9, 2016. Therefore, this request for a supplemental procedural schedule is timely filed.

II. SUPPLEMENTAL PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff is continuing to work with Double Diamond in order to process this docket. Staff has provided Double Diamond with final mapping. Staff will be able to finish its technical review of the application after consent of final mapping is received from Double Diamond. Therefore, Staff proposes a deadline of February 26, 2016 for Staff to provide a final recommendation or to propose a supplemental procedural schedule, if necessary.

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests that the ALJ issue an order consistent with this Response.


