ORDER NO. 1 GRANTING MOTION TO CONTINUE PRELIMINARY HEARING

On July 8, 2009, the Executive Director (ED) of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) forwarded a motion by Inline Utilities, LLC, (Inline) which was sent by its consultant, Jack G. Coblenz, to continue the preliminary hearing in this case that is scheduled for July 29, 2009. Mr. Coblenz has a schedule conflict on that date. Inline proposes that the preliminary hearing be continued to one of several dates, including August 11, 2009.
