

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY (CCN) TO PROVIDE WATER/SEWER UTILITY SERVICE IN HARRIS COUNTY

Inline Utilities, LLC has filed an application with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to provide water & sewer utility service in Harris County. The proposed utility service area is located approximately 5 miles south of downtown Tomball, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Timber Tech Road; on the east by Huffman-Kohrville Rd.; on the south by Spring Cypress Road; and on the west by State Highway 249.

The total area being requested includes 1,011 acres and 0 current customers. A copy of the proposed service area map is available at 10100 Boudreaux Road, Tomball, TX 77375, phone (281) 655-1800.

A request for a public hearing must be in writing. You must state (1) your name, mailing address and daytime telephone number; (2) the applicant's name, application number or another recognizable reference to this application; (3) the statement "I/we request a public hearing"; (4) a brief description of how you or the persons you represent, would be adversely affected by the granting of the application for a CCN; and (5) your proposed adjustment to the application or CCN which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing. Within 15 (30) days from the date of this publication or notice, a public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request or a written request to be notified if a hearing is set will receive notice of a hearing is scheduled.

If a public hearing is requested, the Executive Director will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, the SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be held on a proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

If you are a landowner with a tract and at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the proposed area, you may request to be excluded from the proposed area (or "opt out") by providing written notice to the Commission within (30) days from the date that notice was provided by the applicant. All requests to opt out of the requested service area must include a scaled, general location map and a metes and bounds description of the tract or lands.







The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001, Texas Government Code; Chapter 13, Texas Water Code; TCEQ rules, including 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 291; and the procedural rules of the TCEQ and SOAH, including 30 TAC Chapter 80 and 1 TAC Chapter 155. To participate in the evidentiary hearing as a party, you must attend the preliminary hearing and show you would be affected by the petition in a way not common to members of the general public.
