If there are <u>no protests</u>, you will be provided a copy of the technical staff recommendation and proposed CCN. If the application is <u>contested and a hearing is requested</u>, the application may be referred to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH). During the preliminary hearing, the presiding Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) may give the parties time to negotiate a settlement. Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) is available upon request of all of the parties. If a settlement is reached, the application will be remanded to staff for administrative processing. If a settlement is not reached, a discovery schedule and a date for an evidentiary hearing will be set. The ALJ will take testimony from each party and present a report to the Commission to consider in making a final decision on the application.

3. GIS INFORMATION

We are currently developing a state wide Geographic Information Systems (GIS) coverage of all CCN service areas. The mylar maps are being retired. In order to assist us in this move, we are requesting that a digital file of the proposed CCN service area boundary be submitted with the 3 hard copy maps. **This is not a requirement**. It is understood that not all utilities employ the services of an engineering company or use mapping software to produce a map of the proposed CCN service area boundary. However, by submitting the information digitally, the evaluation of your CCN will be faster and more accurate. Also, by receiving the information in digital form it is easier for us to update and maintain the CCN GIS coverage.

- A. **Digital Map Requirements** In order that your digital data can be properly used, the following information is necessary:
 - Submit digital data of the proposed CCN service area on a 3.25" diskette or CD. Only one diskette or CD is necessary. Most files of CCNs (minus the base map) should be small





The proposed service area is currently an undeveloped area. In July 2008, Inline Utilities LLC plans to develop a multi-family housing unit on the proposed area. Inline Utilities LLC has applied and received a wastewater permit (TPDES Permit No. 13942-002) from the TCEQ for the proposed CCN area, which is located at 23822 State Highway 249, approximately 850 feet north of the intersection of state highway 249 and Coons Road in Harris County. Inline Utilities LLC plans to provide water and sewer services to their tenants. The cost for building and maintaining the wastewater treatment plant and providing drinking water to their tenants is costly, which is why they would like to receive payments for providing these services.

B. Describe the economic need(s) for service in the requested area (i.e. plat approvals, recent annexation(s) or annexation request(s), building permits, septic tank permits, hospitals, etc.); and/or

Inline Utilities LLC plans to develop on the proposed area; therefore, they would like to provide water and sewer service to their tenants. Providing these services is costly, which is why they would like to receive payments from the tenants to help pay for providing these services.

C. Discuss in detail the environmental need(s) for service in the requested area (i.e. failing septic tanks in the requested area, failing wells, etc.); and/or

Inline Utilities LLC plans to develop a wastewater treatment plant in order to provide water and sewer services in the proposed area. Currently, nobody is providing these services in the proposed area because it is undeveloped.

There have been no written applications or requests for service in the proposed CCN area.

E. Provide copies of any reports and/or market studies demonstrating existing or anticipated growth in the requested area.

Inline Utilities LLC is planning on developing multi-family housing within the proposed CCN area.

By amending Inline Utilities current CCN to add the proposed CCN area they would be able to charge their future tenants for providing water and sewer service. These services are costly to the applicant; therefore, they would like to receive some financial support to help maintain this service. Tenants will pay a monthly base rate of \$20.00 for water and \$2.00 for each 1,000 gallons of water used. For sewer service, tenants will pay a monthly base rate of \$25.00 and \$2.00 for each 1,000 gallons of water used. Asking customers to pay a monthly fee will encourage conservation to significantly reduce water wastage.

The Inline Utilities LLC proposed area is approximately 1,010.819 acres and we are proposing that there will be 500 connections.

The proposed land area will have construction take place in order to develop the multifamily housing unit and wastewater treatment plant. While construction takes place Inline Utilities LLC will assure that certain measures are taken in order to prevent degradation of the land. The effect on the land would be minimal.


