defenses (the responding party need not marshal all evidence that may be offered at trial);

1. The Hill Country water systems are not "common" with others with which they have been regionalized by AQUA. For example, high growth urban areas require investment disproportionately greater than small rural areas. Pumping fees and other operating costs are incurred in some counties, but not in others. Note that the Kerrville South Water System investment by AQUA Texas was approximately \$500 over three years per household served while the average investment claimed by AQUA Texas for the SW Region averaged more than \$2,000; 2. It is unjustifiable and unconstitutional to "pass through" operating costs incurred in one county to other counties where no comparable charges are incurred in those counties. Regionalization should not apply to operating costs; 3. Removal of 2,000 gallons from the base rate imposes an unacceptable hardship on low income customers who struggle to use minimal amounts only; 5. Operating costs are inappropriately classified by AQUA Texas as Investments to enable their recovery in subsequent rate increases. For example simple repairs involving leakage and main breaks are included in investments; (6) AQUA Texas profits under the rate increase are excessive. While analysis of financial information supports the need to increase rates the projected results from the rate increase far exceed what might be considered normal and acceptable.; 7. Supplementation of this response will occur as The Hill Country Group completes its review of the information submitted in the application, obtained in discovery or from other sources, presented in prefiled testimony and testimony taken during the evidentiary hearing.

Damages are widely disseminated and extensive, but are not identified at this time, subject to supplementation.
