**ORDER NO. 4  
REQUIRING REISSUANCE OF NOTICE  
AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On April 20, 2015, Order No. 3 was issued in this proceeding, deeming this application administratively complete and requiring the provision of notice using the forms and according to the instructions provided in Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff's April 16, 2015 filing. On June 10, 2015, the City of DeKalb (DeKalb) filed affidavits of notice. On July 15, 2015, Commission Staff filed comments stating that the notice provided by DeKalb was not sufficient, as specifically discussed in Commission Staff's pleading and the attached memorandum of Leila Guerrero, Regulatory Accountant /Auditor, in the Commission's Water Utilities Division. Commission Staff recommended that DeKalb be required to reissue notice according to the instructions provided in its July 15, 2015 pleading and the attached memorandum and proposed a procedural schedule for the continued processing of this application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, DeKalb shall reissue notice of this application consistent with Commission Staff's July 17, 2015 pleading and attached memorandum. Additionally, the procedural schedule proposed by Commission Staff is adopted:

Deadline for DeKalb to resubmit affidavits of notice and the actual notice issued	August 20, 2015
Deadline to intervene, file comments, or request a hearing	30 days after notice is issued
Deadline for Staff to file a recommendation, request for hearing, and/or an additional procedural schedule with hard deadlines	September 22, 2015
