ORDER NO. 7 REQUIRING RE-ISSUANCE OF NOTICE AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On November 18, 2015, Order No. 6 was issued in this proceeding, requiring the City of Dekalb (DeKalb or City) to re-notice this application as the City had been instructed in Order No. 5; consistent with Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff's September 18, 2105 pleading and attached memorandum of Leila Guerrero in the Commission's Water Utilities Regulation Division, using the attached forms. The City did not respond to Order No. 5 or Order No. 6. On January 6, 2015 Commission Staff responded to Order No. 6, stating that the City claims it is working to cure the notice deficiencies in this application. Commission Staff requested that the City be given additional time to cure the notice deficiencies and avoid dismissal of this application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, DeKalb is allowed one more opportunity to cure the deficient notice in this application, as specified by Commission Staff, or this application could be dismissed. The following procedural schedule, as proposed by Commission Staff, shall apply:

Deadline for DeKalb to resubmit affidavits of notice and the actual notice issued	February 5, 2016
Deadline to intervene, file comments, or request a hearing	30 days after notice is issued
Deadline for Staff to file a recommendation, request for hearing, additional procedural schedule, or motion to dismiss	January 7, 2015
