The Application: City of DeKalb filed an application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Bowie County. The total area being requested is located outside and contiguous to the incorporated limits of the City of DeKalb within Bowie County and consists of approximately 64 acres. The proposed area is currently located within the CCN area of Central Bowie County WSC, but they do not have any utilities near the proposed service area. The City of DeKalb has lines in the area and has plans to extend a line to the proposed area. Dual-certification is proposed for this area.
