ORDER NO. 15 ESTABLISHING AND EXTENDING DEADLINES

This Order addresses Commission Staff's September 1, 2016 recommendation to allow three additional months for the City of DeKalb to obtain approval of its Alternative Capacity Request (ACR) by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), if needed, and for a subsequent supplemental final recommendation. On August 15, 2016, DeKalb timely provided a status update with regards to its efforts with regards to preparation and submittal of its ACR to the TCEQ. DeKalb stated that it will likely take its engineer two weeks to determine whether its ACR meets TCEQ's requirements, and if yes, submit the ACR to TCEQ. The city stated that TCEQ usually needs a month or two to process an ACR.

Commission Staff stated that the city has indicated it will need roughly three months to obtain TCEQ approval of its ACR, if needed. Commission Staff recommended a December 1, 2016 deadline for DeKalb to file another status update and a December 21, 2016 deadline for Commission Staff to file a supplemental final recommendation.

Commission Staff's requests are granted. On or before **December 1, 2016**, DeKalb shall file a status update on its ACR and propose a reasonable timeline for completion of the ACR. On or before **December 21, 2016**, Commission Staff shall submit a supplemental final recommendation on this application.
