FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,  
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

**I. Application**

On January 16, 2015, the City of DeKalb filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) on an application to amend a water certificate of convenience and necessity in Bowie County, Texas.

**II. Staff Recommendation on Administrative Completeness of the Application**

On February 17, 2015, Commission Staff filed comments on the application. Commission Staff has determined that the application is not administratively complete due to mapping deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's February 17, 2015, filing and the attached memorandum of Leila Guerrero of the Commission's Water Utilities Division. Pursuant to P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

Applicant should not send out notice to affected parties until the discrepancies noted by Commission Staff are corrected.

**III. Proposed Procedural Schedule**

Commission Staff proposes that Applicant be given until March 18, 2015 to address the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff in its February 17, 2015 filing. Commission Staff proposes to file additional comments regarding completeness of the amended application and notice, once the application has been supplemented.

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
**IV. Finding Application Incomplete and Deficient, Providing Opportunity to Cure**

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, DeKalb's application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **March 18, 2015**, DeKalb shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **April 17, 2015**, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
