I. BACKGROUND

On January 26, 2015, Gonzales County Water Supply Corporation and the City of Gonzales (collectively, Applicants) filed an application, pursuant to TEX. WATER CODE § 13.248 (TWC), for approval of an agreement to decertify and transfer a certain 138.62 acre tract of land located within Gonzales County WSC's certificated area. On November 12, 2015, the Order No. 8 was issued, which set December 9, 2015 as the deadline for parties to submit a proposed notice of approval.

II. PROPOSED NOTICE OF APPROVAL

JOINT PROPOSED NOTICE OF APPROVAL

This Joint Notice of Approval addresses the application (Application) of the City of Gonzales (Gonzales) and the Gonzales County Water Supply Corporation (Gonzales WSC) for approval, pursuant to TEX. WATER CODE (TWC) § 13.248, of an agreement to decertify and transfer a certain 138.62 acre tract of land located within Gonzales WSC's certificated area to Gonzales. The Public Utility Commission Staff recommended approval of this application. The application is approved.

The Commission adopts the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

I. FINDINGS OF FACT

Procedural History and Background

- 1. On January 26, 2015, Gonzales WSC and Gonzales (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for approval of an agreement to decertify and transfer a certain 138.62 acre tract of land located within Gonzales County WSC's certificated area to Gonzales.
- 2. On April 17, 2015, Order No. 3 was issued, declaring the application administratively complete and requiring that notice of the application be provided.
- 3. On June 2, 2015, Gonzales WSC filed an affidavit attesting that mailed notice was provided on May 29, 2015.
- 4. No hearing requests, comments, or protests were received.
- 5. On November 4, 2015, Gonzales WSC submitted a signed consent form evidencing its consent to the map and certificates.
- 6. On November 12. 2015, Gonzales submitted a signed consent form evidencing its consent to the map and certificates.
- 7. On November 20, 2015 Staff recommended that the Application be approved.

8. The following evidence is admitted into the record of this proceeding: (a) Application, filed on Jan. 26, 2015 (Commission automated interchange system (AIS) Item No. 1); (b) affidavit dated May 29, 2015, attesting to notice mailed on May 29, 2015 (AIS Item No. 9); (c) Commission Staff's recommendation regarding final disposition, filed on November 20, 2015 (AIS Item No. 24).

Informal Disposition

- 9. More than 15 days have passed since completion of the notice provided in this docket.
- 10. No entity submitted a request for hearing. No issues of fact or law remain are by any party; therefore, no hearing is necessary.

II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- The Commission has jurisdiction and authority over this docket pursuant to TWC §§ 13.041, 13.241, and 13.248 and 16 TAC §§ 24.101 and 24.117.
- 2. Gonzales and Gonzales WSC are retail public utilities as defined in § 13.002(19).
- Gonzales WSC provided public notice of the Application in compliance with TWC § 13.248 and 16 TAC § 24.117.
- 4. Gonzales demonstrated that an amendment of its CCN No. 11210 is necessary for the service, accommodation, convenience, or safety of the public.
- 5. The requirements for informal disposition pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.35 have been met in this proceeding.

III. ORDERING PARAGRAPHS

In accordance with these findings of fact and conclusions of law, the Commission issues the following Order:


- 1. The Applicants' January 26, 2015, Application is approved.
- City of Gonzales' water CCN No. 11210 is hereby amended to include the previously disputed area.
- Gonzales County WSC's CCN No. 10704 is hereby amended to delete the previously disputed area.
- 4. The City of Gonzales and Gonzales WSC, respectively, per attached Certificates of Necessity No. 11210 and No. 10704, shall serve every future customer and applicant for service within their respective areas, the transferred area being hereby assigned and included within the City

of Gonzales' CCN No. 11210 [and deleted from Gonzales County WSC's CCN No. 10704] and service by each of these referenced Applicants shall be continuous and adequate as required by their agreement and the law applicable to such service areas.
