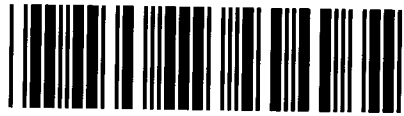

To request a hearing, you must:

- (1) state your name, mailing address and daytime telephone number;
- (2) state the applicant's name, application number or another recognizable reference to this application;
- (3) include the statement "I/we request a public hearing";

- (4) write a brief description of how you, the persons you represent, or the public interest would be adversely affected by the proposed transfer of the CCN; and
- (5) state your proposed adjustment to the application or CCN which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

Only those persons who submit a written request to be notified of a hearing will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled. The Commission will issue the CCN requested in the referenced application unless a hearing is scheduled to consider the transfer. If no protests or requests for hearing are filed during the comment period, the Commission may issue the CCN 30 days after publication of this notice.
