ORDER NO. 5 DEEMING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, ADDRESSING NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

I. Application

On January 28, 2015, the City of Austin (COA) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application requesting to cancel Lost Creek MUD's water certificate of convenience (CCN) No. 10307 and wastewater CCN No. 20118 in Travis County, Texas. The application was deemed deficient on March 4, 2015 and again on May 15, 2015. On April 14, 2015 and June 5, 2015, COA filed amendments to the application.

II. Administrative Completeness

On July 7, 2015, Commission Staff filed supplemental comments on the sufficiency of COA's amended application. Commission Staff finds that COA's application as amended is sufficient for further review. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Applicant's application is deemed administratively complete.

III. Notice

Commission Staff has reviewed COA's proposed notice with regard to applicable statutes and rules, and recommends COA send the notice as described in Commission Staff's July 7, 2015 filing and the attached memorandum of Elizabeth English and Komal Patel of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, using the forms attached to the Commission Staff memorandum. Staff recommended published notice be waived as a result of the notices distributed during the annexation of the area.

Consistent with Staff's recommendation, COA shall provide notice as described in Staff's recommendation. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code §24.105(d), publication of notice is waived. COA shall file affidavits evidencing proof of notice by the deadline set forth below.

IV. **Procedural Schedule**

The following procedural schedule as proposed by Commission Staff is adopted:

Deadline for Applicant to provide the Commission with the Affidavits of Notice, the individual notice actually issued, along with the accompanying map	August 7, 2015
Deadline for affected persons other than Staff to file comments, intervene or request a hearing	30 days after notice is issued
Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or to file a supplemental procedural schedule	September 18, 2015
