**AGREEMENT TO PASS THE SETTING FOR THE PREHEARING CONFERENCE
CURRENTLY SCHEDULED TO BE HEARD ON JULY 10, 2015**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Agreement to Pass the Setting for the Prehearing Conference currently scheduled to be heard on July 10, 2015, and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On February 24, 2015, ratepayers of the City of Wilmer who live outside of the City limits (Petitioners) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an appeal of the decision by the City of Wilmer to increase water rates (Petition).

On June 16, 2015, Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Lilo D. Pomerleau issued SOAH Order No.2. That order adopted the schedule the parties proposed for trying the case. After the parties conferred regarding what would be discussed at the prehearing conference, all agreed that there is no need for a prehearing conference. The schedule has already been set and no party has any pretrial motion regarding party status or jurisdiction pending. If the ALJ decides that a prehearing conference is necessary, the parties will confer to reschedule the prehearing conference, but will the parties will be unavailable tomorrow.

III. Conclusion


Commission Staff requests that the prehearing conference be passed.
