**COMMISSION STAFF'S PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this Commission Staff's Proposed Procedural Schedule. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

**I. BACKGROUND**

On February 26, 2015, Founders Reserve Community Association, Inc. (Founders or Applicant) filed with the Commission an application (Application) to obtain new water and sewer certificates of convenience and necessity in Montgomery County, Texas.

Order No. 10 instructed Staff to file a recommendation or an additional procedural schedule no later than February 12, 2016. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

**II. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

The Applicant agreed to work with Staff to resolve questions raised by responses to RFIs. Staff and the Applicant participated in a conference call on January 26, 2016. The conversation left Staff with unresolved concerns, including concerns about the need for a PWS from TCEQ; however, Staff would like to make one last attempt to communicate with the Applicant in order to determine if the parties have reached an impasse or whether there is potential to move forward with the Application. Therefore, Staff proposes that it be allowed until February 24, 2016 to make a final recommendation or propose an additional procedural schedule.


### III. CONCLUSION
