**ORDER NO. 3  
FINDING APPLICATION REMAINS ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT; AND ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**


On June 11, 2015, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff Commission Staff filed comments finding, following the filing of supplemental materials by City of Dripping Springs, that the application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. Commission Staff proposed that City of Dripping Springs be given until July 10, 2015, to cure the mapping deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Commission Staff proposes to file, by August 7, 2015, additional comments regarding completeness of the revised application and proposed notice.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **July 10, 2015**, City of Dripping Springs shall amend its application to cure the mapping deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **August 7, 2015**, Commission Staff shall file additional comments on the administrative completeness of the revised application and notice, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
