To Whom It May Concern:


It is our understanding that the Public Utility Commission (PUC) staff has advised the City of Dripping Springs to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) requires the City to obtain consent for the amendment from the Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority (GBRA).

GBRA is not aware that any consent from GBRA is actually required. GBRA is a river authority with a service area that generally includes the area that is the subject of Docket No. 44523. However, GBRA does not provide potable water service within the proposed service area.

CCN amendments occur with some regularity within GBRA's boundaries, and we would like to better understand the specific statute or rule by which the PUC staff believes GBRA's consent is necessary. If you could direct us to a contact within the PUC, we would like to learn more about the Commission's concerns regarding this issue generally.

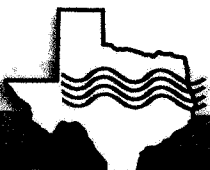
