**ORDER NO. 4  
FINDING APPLICATION SUFFICIENT, REQUIRING NOTICE,  
AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On May 29, 2015, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff filed a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the above-styled and numbered application. Commission Staff recommended that the application is sufficient for filing. Commission Staff's recommendation included instructions for provision of notice as well as sample draft notice forms and a sample draft affidavit of notice. Commission Staff stated that notice should not be provided until ordered.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is found to be sufficient for filing. Aqua Texas, Inc. may proceed with provision of notice in the manner and form described in Commission Staff's recommendation.

Commission Staff proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket. Accordingly, the following schedule shall apply:

Deadline for Aqua Texas, Inc. to file copies of actual notices issued and a signed affidavit of notice	Within 45 calendar days of the issuance of this Order
Deadline to intervene; deadline for intervenors to request a hearing	Within 30 calendar days of mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later
Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing, or to file a recommendation on final disposition	Within 45 calendar days from the end of the intervention period

Deadline for Aqua Texas, Inc. to request a hearing or respond to Commission Staff's recommendation on final disposition; or if no disputed issues exist, deadline for parties to file a notice of approval, including findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs

Within 10 working days from Commission Staff's recommendation on final disposition
