ORDER NO. 6
FINDING ADDITIONAL CLOSING DOCUMENTS SUFFICIENT AND
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE FOR CONTINUED PROCESSING

On March 16, 2015, Ranch Utilities, L.P. (Ranch Utilities) and Quadvest, L.P. (Quadvest) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Montgomery County associated with serving the Caddo Village subdivision.

On December 22, 2015, the closing documentation was found to be insufficient because the closing documentation did not demonstrate the approved sale and transfer transaction related to the instant proceeding. Rather, the documentation demonstrated an assignment between Ranch Utilities and various individuals.

On January 8, 2016, Quadvest filed additional closing documents, including the assignment of certain assets to Quadvest.

On February 8, 2016, Commission Staff's recommended, following a review of the additional closing documents, that Applicants have consummated their sale and transfer transaction, including customer deposits.


Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the additional closing documentation is deemed sufficient and the following procedural schedule is adopted as proposed by Commission Staff:
