### WALLER COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT MOTION TO INTERVENE

TO THE HONORABLE Lilo D. Pomerleau, Administrative Law Judge:

COMES NOW, the Waller County Commissioners Court ("County") and files this, its Motion to Intervene pursuant to PUC Proc R. §§ 22.103 and 22.104.

#### I. Standing to Intervene/Justiciable Interest

Procedural Rule 22.103(b) states that a person has standing to intervene if that person "has or represents persons with a justiciable interest which may be adversely affected by the outcome of the proceeding."

The County is responsible to protect the health, welfare and safety of its citizens. On March 18, 2015, the County passed a resolution, attached hereto and incorporated in its entirety herein, finding it in the public interest and to the benefit of the residents of the town/county and the citizens of the state to support the no-build option for the Brazos Valley Connection electrical transmission line project a/k/a the CenterPoint Project. (Attachment 1) On June 3, 2015, the Court adopted a resolution, attached hereto and incorporated in its entirety herein, to seek intervention in SOAH Docket 473-15-3595 in opposition of CenterPoint's application for the amendment of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity. will have their private property taken and other properties will see a reduction in property values,

thus diminishing the tax base of the County. Moreover, the County believes the CenterPoint

Project, if approved, would detract from the beauty and integrity of the County's environment

and could cause adverse environmental and health impacts. Therefore, the County believes that,

on behalf of its citizens, it has a justiciable interest, which may be adversely affected by the

outcome of this proceeding.

The CenterPoint transmission line, no matter which route is selected, would cross the

County and its multiple public roads. The County has easements for many of the County roads.

The County is concerned about the effect new transmission lines would have on its

infrastructure, mainly public roads. The County supervises and maintains public roads within the

County and objects to any route that will adversely impact the County's infrastructure, and

thereby its long term transportation plans. The County has a justiciable interest that could be

adversely impacted by approval of CenterPoint's application with any and all of the alternative

routes included in the application.

#### WALLER COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2015, CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC (CenterPoint) filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUC) to amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) for a 345-kilovolt transmission line in Grimes, Harris and Waller Counties, Texas (a/k/a the CenterPoint Project" or "the Brazos Valley Connection Electrical Transmission Line Project"); and

WHEREAS, on April 6, 2015, the Waller County Sub-Regional Planning Commission adopted a Resolution supporting the no-build option for CenterPoint Brazos Valley Connection Electrical Transmission Line Project; and

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2015, Waller County adopted a Resolution supporting the nobuild option for the CenterPoint Brazos Valley Connection Electrical Transmission Line Project; and

WHEREAS, the Resolutions of Waller County and the Waller County Sub-Regional Planning Commission are incorporated for all purposes in this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the PUC has referred CenterPoint's application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a contested case hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Waller County Commissioners Court believe there is no need for the CenterPoint Project and, if the CenterPoint Project is approved, citizens of Waller County will have their private property taken and other properties will see a reduction in property values, thus diminishing the tax base for Waller County; and

WHEREAS, the Waller County Commissioners Court believe the CenterPoint Project, if approved, would detract from the beauty and integrity of the County's environment and could cause adverse environmental impacts; and

WHEREAS, the Waller County Commissioners Court believe that, on behalf of its citizens, it is necessary to intervene in the SOAH proceeding concerning the CenterPoint Project.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Waller County Commissioners Court authorizes the law firm of Fritz, Byrne, Head & Fitzpatrick, PLLC to seek intervention in SOAH Docket No. 473-15-3595; PUC Docket No. 44547 on behalf of the Waller County Commissioners Court in opposition of CenterPoint's application for the amendment of the CCN.
