MOTION TO AMEND CERTAIN PROCEDURAL DEADLINES

CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC (“CenterPoint Houston”) submits this Motion to Amend the deadlines for filing testimony in this proceeding. The Company and Intervenor¹ are presently working to determine whether a settlement can be reached that would resolve all contested issues in this proceeding. In order to facilitate these discussions, CenterPoint Houston has communicated with Intervenor¹ in this case regarding the following proposed changes to the procedural schedule:

May 27, 2015, by noon	Intervenor ¹ file request for hearing and direct testimony
June 3, 2015, by noon	Staff files request for hearing and direct testimony, or recommendation on final disposition if no hearing requested
June 8, 2015, by 5:00 pm	CenterPoint serves rebuttal testimony electronically to all parties and ALJ
June 9, 2015, hard copy filed with Commission	CenterPoint files rebuttal testimony at Commission

All other dates in the procedural schedule remain in place, including the date for the Hearing on the Merits, which is currently scheduled for June 15, 2015, and the proposed effective date for DCRF rates, which is September 1, 2015. Gulf Coast Coalition of Cities, Texas Industrial Energy Consumers, Texas Coast Utilities Coalition, City of Houston, the Houston Coalition of Cities, Alliance for Retail Markets, State Agencies, the Office of Public Utility Counsel, and the




