STATUS REPORT AND MOTION FOR CONTINUED ABATEMENT

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) and files this Status Report and Motion for Continued Abatement. In support thereof, the Staff would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On March 31, 2015, Rolling Hills Water Service, Inc. (Rolling Hills or Applicant) filed an Application for a Water Rate/Tariff Change (Application) for water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 12724 in Hood County, Texas pursuant to Tex. Water Code § 13.187 (TWC) and 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.22 (TAC). Rolling Hills reported an adjusted annual revenue requirement of \$47,529 and proposed an effective date of June 1, 2015.

Order No. 2, issued on December 3, 2015, abated this case due to settlement discussions between the Applicant and Staff.

II. CONTINUED ABATEMENT

Staff and Applicant are in the process of finalizing a settlement agreement and plan on filing it the week of April 11, 2016. Staff and Applicant therefore request the abatement be continued until April 20, 2016.

III. CONCLUSION

Staff requests the entry of an order granting this motion to continue abatement.




