
II. PURPOSE AND SCOPE OF TESTIMONY
QUESTION: WHAT IS THE PURPOSE AND SCOPE OF YOUR TESTIMONY?
ANSWER: The purpose of my testimony is to (a) describe my property, (b) describe
the expected impact of the proposed transmission line on my property and (c) voice my
opposition against any route that uses Link KK and U, including Routes 203, 222, 252,
274-279 and 289, and voice my support for Route 18.
QUESTION: WHAT IS THE DICKERSON ALLIANCE'S CONCERNS ABOUT THE PROPOSED TRANSMISSION LINE USING LINKS KK OR U?
ANSWER: In general, THE DICKERSON ALLIANCE is opposed to the construction
of CTT's transmission line through their community because of the following: (1) a 345
kV transmission line will severely depreciate the value of THE DICKERSON
ALLIANCE properties; (2) a 345 kV transmission line will severely detract from the
scenic beauty and aesthetic values of THE DICKERSON ALLIANCE properties and
area; (3) a 345 kV transmission line would negatively impact community, economic and
historical values and character of THE DICKERSON ALLIANCE properties and area;
(4) THE DICKERSON ALLIANCE and visitors will have to drive under or near a 345
kV transmission line on a regular basis; (5) for transmission lines crossing a Dickerson
Alliance property, they would be required to give third parties access to their properties,
which limits the privacy and control over our properties; and (6) THE DICKERSON
ALLIANCE has general concerns about any buzzing of the 345kV transmission line and
general health and safety concerns and concerns living and being close to a 345 kV
transmission line.

1	III. <u>DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY AND THE LINE'S IMPACT</u>
2 3 4 5 6	QUESTION: ARE THERE ANY HABITABLE STRUCTURES ON THE PROPERTY?
7	ANSWER: Yes, there are two houses. Both are one story with one 4/2 and the other 2/2.
8	There are also two equipment barns. The 4/2 is about 250 to 400 feet from Segment KK
9	and the 2/2 is 400 to 500 feet from it.

11 12 13 14	QUESTION: PLEASE DESCRIBE YOUR PROPERTY'S CURRENT USES. ANSWER: Housing for our family and storage facilities for farm equipment.
15 16 17 18	QUESTION: ARE THERE ANY WATER WELL SITES ON THE PROPERTY? IF SO, DESCRIBE THE GENERAL LOCATION.
20	ANSWER: Yes, near the home.
21 22 23 24 25 26 27	QUESTION: DO ANY EXISTING TRANSMISSION OR DISTRIBUTION LINES CROSS YOUR PROPERTY? IF SO, PLEASE DESCRIBE HOW AND WHERE THEY CROSS THE PROPERTY. ANSWER: No existing transmission lines. Normal electricity lines to supply

29	electricity to the houses, barns and wells are present. The distribution line border our property at the CR 419.

31 32 33 34 35 36 37	QUESTION: WOULD THE LINKS THAT MIGHT IMPACT YOUR PROPERTY RUN ALONG ANY BOUNDARY LINES OF YOUR PROPERTY? ANSWER: Segment KK bisects through the middle my property.

1 2 3	QUESTION: HOW WOULD A 345KV ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION LINE IMPACT YOUR PROPERTY AND ITS OPERATIONS?
4	ANSWER: There is a small pond over which the Segment KK would pass and it is too
5	close to our houses. We are also concerned about how it effects our ability to continue
6	living normally as we have since we've been here. Again, Segment KK would be too
7	close to the houses and the electrical noise would also be troubling.

11 12 13 14	QUESTION: IF THE TRANSMISSION LINE IS BUILT ON YOUR PROPERTY, DO YOU HAVE ANY CONCERNS ABOUT CTT HAVING ACCESS TO YOUR PROPERTY?
15	ANSWER: Yes, we have the general concerns of landowners who are required to
16	give third parties access to their property. Also, this would materially affect the use of
17	our property. I hope that CTT will respect my property.
18 19 20 21 22	QUESTION: IF THE TRANSMISSION LINE IS BUILT ON YOUR PROPERTY, DO YOU HAVE ANY OTHER CONCERNS?
23	ANSWER: We have general safety and health concerns for living around transmission
24	lines and EMF issues. Because potential buyers may be aware of medical studies
25	available on the Internet arguing, correctly or not, a connection between high-powered
26	transmission lines causing health problems and possible cancer, we are concerned about a
27	negative stigma being attached to our property and the possible devaluation of our
28	property value. In addition, the buzzing sounds emanating from high-voltage
29	transmission lines would be bothersome for people living near them.
30 31 32 33 34	QUESTION: IS THERE ANYTHING ELSE YOU WOULD LIKE THE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE AND THE PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION TO CONSIDER IN THIS PROCEEDING?
