**ORDER NO. 6**  
**DEEMING AMENDED PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,**  
**ADDRESSING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

**I. Petition**

On April 22, 2015, the City of Houston filed, with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), a petition to cancel Bellewood Water Supply Corporation's (Bellewood WSC's) water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 12476 in Harris County. Bellewood WSC forfeited its corporate charge in 2009.

On July 29, 2015, the City of Houston filed supplemental materials to its petition and notice.

**II. Administrative Completeness**

On August 14, 2015, Commission Staff recommended, following a review of the City of Houston's petition and supplemental materials, that the identified deficiencies had been cured, but, due to the unique nature of this proceeding, were still completing a determination of both the appropriate method and form of notice to Bellewood WSC and how to process this proceeding.

On September 4, 2015, Commission Staff recommended that the City of Houston's amended petition be deemed administratively complete. Accordingly, the City of Houston's amended petition is deemed administratively complete.

**III. Notice**

Commission Staff directed the City of Houston to provide notice consistent with the instructions included with Commission Staff's September 4, 2015, filing. Additionally,

Commission Staff proposed to provide notice to Bellewood WSC by certified mail, return receipt requested, and requested approval of its proposed notice to Bellewood WSC.

Consistent with Staff's recommendation, City of Houston shall provide notice as described in Commission Staff's September 4, 2015, recommendation using the attached forms. Commission Staff's proposed notice to Bellewood WSC is approved. Commission Staff shall provide notice to Bellewood WSC as described in its recommendation.

The City of Houston and Commission Staff shall file affidavits evidencing proof of notice in accordance with the schedule set out below.

#### IV. Procedural Schedule

The following procedural schedule as proposed by Commission Staff is adopted:
