Crystal Clear Water Supply Corporation filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to obtain a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity for the provision of sewer utility service in Comal County.

The proposed utility service area is located approximately Z miles Northeast of downtown New Braunfels, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north $\frac{1}{2}$ mile south of Watson Lane; on the east by <u>Union Pacific Rail Road</u>; on the south by <u>1</u> mile north of Conrads Lane; and on the west by <u>FM 1102</u>.

See enclosed map of the proposed service area.

The total area being requested includes approximately <u>88</u> acres and <u>184</u> current customers.

A request for a public hearing must be in writing. You must state (1) your name, mailing address, and daytime telephone number; (2) the applicant's name, application number or another recognizable reference to this application; (3) the statement, "I/we request a public hearing"; (4) a brief description of how you or the persons you represent, would be adversely affected by the granting of the application for a CCN; and (5) your proposed adjustment to the application or CCN which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

Persons who wish to intervene or comment should write the:

Public Utility Commission of Texas Central Records 1701 N. Congress, P. O. Box 13326 Austin, TX 78711-3326 within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication or notice. A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request or a written request to be notified if a hearing is set will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.

If a public hearing is requested, the Commission will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, the SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

If you are a landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the proposed area, you may request to exclude the tract from the proposed area (or "opt out") by providing written notice to the Commission within (30) days from the date that notice was provided by the applicant. All request to opt out of the requested service area must include a scaled, general location map and a metes and bounds description of the tract of land.

Persons who meet the requirements to opt out, and wish to request this option should file the required documents with the:

A copy of the request to opt out of the proposed area must also be sent to the applicant. Staff may request additional information regarding your request.
