### ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

### I. Application

On May 1, 2015, Crystal Clear Water Supply (Applicant) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application to obtain a new sewer certificate of convenience and necessity in Comal County, Texas.

# II. Staff Recommendation on Administrative Completeness of the Application

On June 1, 2015, Commission Staff filed comments on the application. Commission Staff has determined that the application is not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's June 1, 2015 filing and the attached memorandum of Sean Scaff and Suzanne Bert of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

In addition, Applicant should not publish notice of the application until these deficiencies are corrected and approved by Staff.

## III. Proposed Procedural Schedule

Commission Staff proposes that Applicant be given until June 12, 2015 to address the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Commission Staff proposes to file additional comments regarding completeness of the amended application, along with a proposed procedural schedule once the application is administratively complete.

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# IV. Finding Application Incomplete and Deficient, Providing Opportunity to Cure

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **June 12, 2015**, Applicant shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before July 3, 2015 Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule.
