**ORDER NO. 4
DEEMING APPLICATION DEFICIENT;
SETTING DEADLINES FOR APPLICANT AND COMMISSION STAFF**

On May 6, 2015, Quadvest, L.P. (Quadvest) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application to amend its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11612 and sewer CCN No. 20952 in Harris County. On June 11, 2014, Order No. 2 was issued, deeming the application deficient and incomplete.

On August 28, 2015, Commission Staff filed supplemental comments regarding administrative completeness of the application. Commission Staff stated that there are material deficiencies in the application, as specifically described in the pleading and attached memorandum of Sean Scaff and Komal Patel of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a), the application is not considered filed until the Commission determines that the application and notice are administratively complete; thus, at this time, the application is not considered filed with the Commission.


Commission Staff proposed that Quadvest be given until September 28, 2015 to address the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Commission Staff proposed a deadline of October 27, 2015 to file additional comments regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Quadvest's application remains deficient and incomplete. On or before **September 28, 2015**, Quadvest shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Quadvest shall not send out notice to affected parties until this application is deemed administratively complete and it is ordered to do so. On or before **October 27, 2015**, Commission Staff shall file additional comments regarding administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
