ORDER NO. 10 EXTENDING DEADLINE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's request to extend its March 9, 2016 deadline for supplemental comments to March 25, 2016. Order No. 8 found that this application remains deficient, and established two deadlines; February 24, 2016 for Quadvest, L.P. to provide a status update and all information needed to cure all deficiencies previously identified by Commission Staff and a March 9, 2016 deadline for Commission staff to file a supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of this application and if the recommendation is that the application remains deficient, to comment on whether the application should be dismissed.

On March 4, 2016, Quadvest late-filed a request for a continued abatement to cure the deficiencies in this application and explained that the company was in the process of requesting decertification of the overlap with Aqua Texas. On March 8, 2016, Order No. 9 was issued, requiring Quadvest to file proof that an application that will clear the overlap with the certificated service area requested in this application had been filed with the Commission no later than March 22, 2016, and stating that Quadvest's request for a continued abatement will be considered at that time. Quadvest has not made a filing responsive to Order No. 9, therefore its request for a continued abatement is not addressed in this Order.

Commission Staff's request for an opportunity to file its supplemental comments on administrative completeness of this application after Quadvest's new deadline is granted. On or before March 25, 2016, Commission Staff shall file supplemental comments on administrative completeness of this application, propose a supplemental procedural schedule or recommend dismissal.
