Th motorized, self-balancin scooters — not the floatin board Marty McFly rod in the "Back to the Future films — contain lithium io batteries that can overhea and catch fire or explode the Consumer Produc Safety Commission said.

The agency said it has received at least 99 inciden reports about the batter problems to date, includ ing complaints about burn injuries and property dam age.

"Consumers should im mediately stop using these recalled products and con tact the recalling company to return their hoverboarc for a full refund, a free repair or a free replacemen depending on the model,' the agency said.

The recall affects hover boards from a several man ufacturers, but more than half of the recalled units were from Indiana-basec Swagway.
