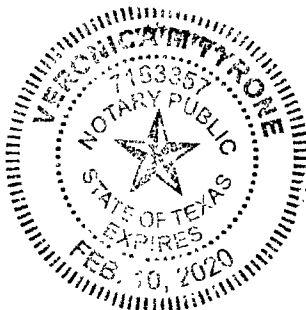

A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request or a written request to be notified if a hearing is set will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.

If a public hearing is requested, the Commission will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

If you are a landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the proposed area, you may request to be excluded from the proposed area (or "opt out") by providing written notice to the Commission within (30) days from the date that notice was provided by the applicant. All requests to opt out of the requested service area must include a scaled, general location map and a meets and bounds description of the tract of land.

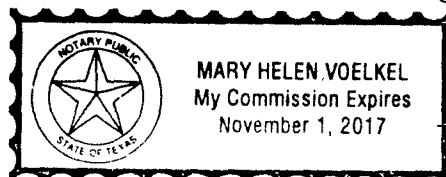

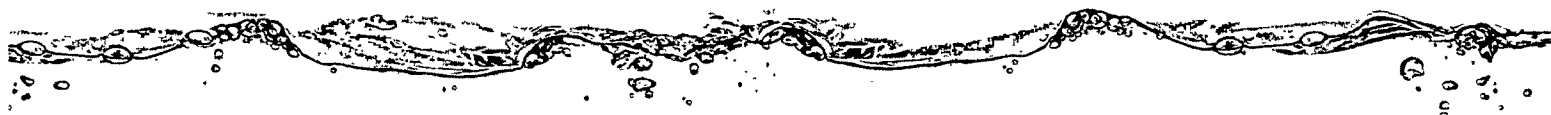

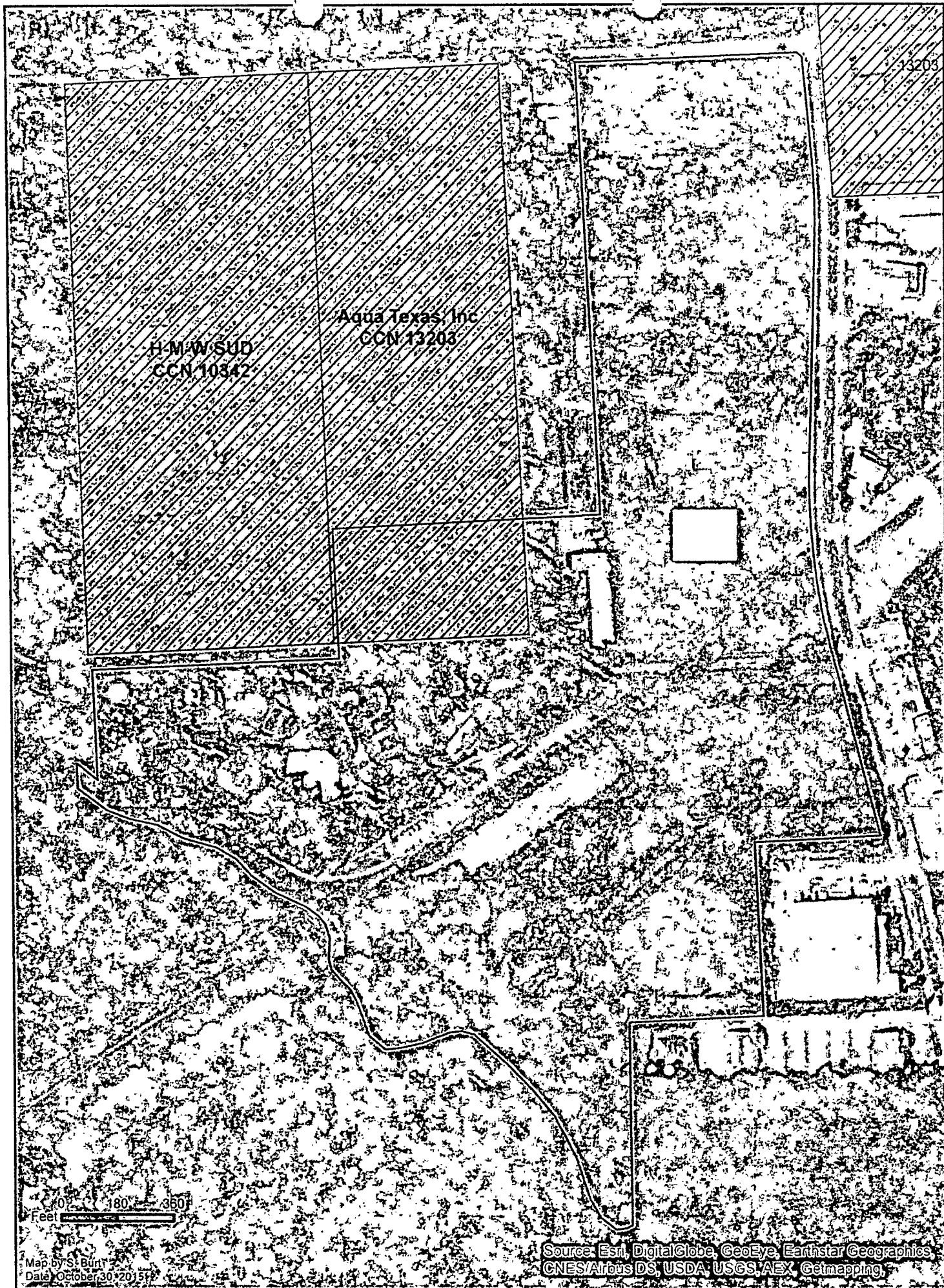

The booming areas were on Houston's edges, Pasadena, Clear Lake, Pearland, Kingwood and Deer Park. These areas, especially those to the east, have been strong with a supply of lower-priced homes with proximity to the petrochemical industry.

"We have a buyer's market in the high end, and we have a seller's market in the \$300,000 and below end," said Toni Nelson, the director of strategic initiatives at Better Homes and Gardens Real Estate Gary Greene.

The 7,696 homes sold in June was similar to the 7,710 sold in the same month a year earlier, according to the HAR report. There were 3.7 months of inventory built up, a slight increase, but still considered a tight market. The national

Half a recall

U.S. regulators announced recalls of more than 500,000 "hoverboards" Wednesday. The motorized, self-balancing scooters — not the floating board Marty McFly rode in the "Back to the Future" films — contain lithium ion batteries that can overheat and catch fire or explode, the Consumer Product Safety Commission said.

The agency said it has received at least 99 incident reports about the battery problems to date, including complaints about burn injuries and property damage.

"Consumers should immediately stop using these recalled products and contact the recalling company to return their hoverboard for a full refund, a free repair or a free replacement depending on the model," the agency said.

The recall affects hoverboards from a several manufacturers, but more than half of the recalled units were from Indiana-based Swagway.
