ORDER NO. 2 DEEMING APPLICATION DEFICIENT; SETTING DEADLINES FOR APPLICANT AND COMMISSION STAFF

On May 6, 2015, Quadvest, L.P. (Quadvest) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 11612 and sewer CCN No. 20952 in Harris County.

On June 8, 2015, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff filed comments regarding the administrative completeness of this application. Commission Staff stated that there are material deficiencies in the application, as specifically described in the pleading and attached memorandum of Sean Scaff, Engineering Specialist, Water Utilities Division. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a) (TAC), the application is not considered filed until the Commission determines that the application and notice are administratively complete; thus, at this time, the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

Commission Staff proposed that Applicant be given until July 8, 2015 to address the deficiencies identified in its June 8, 2015 filing. Commission Staff proposed a deadline of August 10, 2015 to file additional comments regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule if deemed administratively complete.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Quadvest's application is deemed deficient. On or before **July 8, 2015**, Quadvest shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Applicant shall not send out notice to affected parties until these discrepancies are corrected. Commission Staff proposed a deadline of **August 10, 2015** to file additional comments regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule if deemed administratively complete.
