ANSWERS TO COMMISSION STAFF'S FIRST REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO MSEC ENTERPRISES, INC. QUESTION NOS. STAFF 1-1 THROUGH STAFF 1-3

- Staff 1-1 Please provide all information on the costs for constructing, operating, and maintaining the system and the revenue amount that will be generated from the Montgomery Independent School District to pay for the new system, along with projected profit and loss statements, cash flow worksheets, and balance sheets for each of the first five years of operation.
- Answer: CONSTRUCTION: Applicant engaged the engineering firm of McClure & Browne (the "Engineer") to design and generate plans and specifications for the construction of the Wastewater Plant that will serve only Montgomery Independent School District ("MISD"). Applicant and MISD have agreed that (1) Applicant will construct the Plant on real property contributed to Applicant by MISD; (2) the Wastewater Plant will include a Reuse Water Plant; (3) MISD will contribute to Applicant 100% of the costs to construct each Plant attributable to the capacity requirements of MISD as agreed upon; and, (4) MISD will be entitled to 100% of the capacity of the Plants attributable to the contribution made to Applicant for the construction of the Plants. The Engineer has prepared an Engineer's Preliminary Opinion as to costs to be incurred in the construction of each plant sufficient to provide the capacity requirements of MISD dated September 1, 2015, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "A" to these answers. This document is subject to revision. Applicant and MISD are in the process of completing a contract for the construction of the Wastewater Plant and Reuse Plant for the amount that will be agreed upon and as reflected in a final opinion as to costs to be issued by the Engineer and agreed upon by MISD and Applicant. Applicant will supplement as relevant changes in circumstances require.

OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE: Applicant is in the process of reviewing all anticipated costs of operating and maintaining the Wastewater Plant and the Reuse Plant. Applicant and MISD have agreed in principle to enter into a Wastewater Service Agreement with MISD that will provide a monthly contracted amount for which Applicant will operate and maintain the two Plants. Operation and maintenance costs will include cost associated with materials, utilities, repairs, labor, and administration. Applicant will supplement as relevant changes in circumstances require.

REVENUE: Applicant is analyzing the data prepared and being revised by the Engineer to develop the financials requested. Applicant will supplement as the financial information is developed.

- Staff 1-2 Please provide approval documentation of the wastewater permit submitted to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
- Answer: Applicant filed its Application for Wastewater Permit with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("TCEQ") on or about February 3, 2015. TCEQ issued its preliminary opinion letter on or about July 16, 2015. A copy of the TCEQ Central Records status report as of September 8, 2015, is attached as Exhibit "B". The Application is pending before the TCEQ. Applicant will pursue the Application until completion. Applicant will supplement as relevant changes in circumstances require.
- Staff 1-3 Please provide written consent from Lonestar GCD and the SJRA pursuant to Texas Water Code§ 13.244(c) and 16 Tex. Admin Code§ 24.105(a)(4).
- Answer: Applicant gave written notice of its Application for Amendment of its Sewer CCN # 20984 to Lone Star Ground Water Conservation District and San Jacinto River Authority on or about August 24, 2015. After receipt of this Commission Staff First Request for Information, Applicant specifically requested the written consent of both Lone Star GCD and San Jacinto River Authority.

Lone Star GCD issued its written response indicating that it had no authority to consent to the Application or issuance of the CCN Amendment. Please see the email response from Samantha Reider with Lone Star GCD dated September 3, 2015, attached as Exhibit "C".

San Jacinto River Authority issued its consent dated September 10, 2015, a true and correct copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "D".
