COMMISSION STAFF'S MOTION TO CONTINUE ABATEMENT

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, files this Motion to Continue Abatement, and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On May 18, 2015, MSEC Enterprises, Inc. (MSEC) filed an application to amend sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 20984 in Montgomery County. On January 17, 2017, Order No. 8 was issued, granting Staff's request to continue the abatement until February 13, 2017, at which point the parties are required to file a joint status report or a joint motion to unabate this docket for further processing.

II. MOTION TO CONTINUE ABATEMENT

It is Staff's understanding that counsel for MSEC, Mr. John M. Fultz, is involved with a family emergency and the parties cannot make a joint statement at this time. Accordingly, Staff recommends that the proceeding continue to be abated until March 15, 2017, at which point the will file a status report or a joint motion to unabate this docket for further processing.
