JOINT STATUS REPORT

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this Joint Status Report and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On May 18, 2015, MSEC Enterprises, Inc. (MSEC) filed an application to amend sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 20984 in Montgomery County. On February 15, 2017, Order No. 9 was issued, granting Staff's request to continue the abatement until March 15, 2017, at which point the parties are required to file a joint status report or a joint motion to unabate this docket for further processing.

II. JOINT STATUS REPORT

On March 13, 2017, MSEC filed a notice of substitution of counsel. Staff has discussed the procedure with MSEC's new counsel, and the parties request that the abatement be continued until April 14, 2017 to allow MSEC's new counsel sufficient time to acquaint itself with the proceeding, at which point the parties will file a status report or a joint motion to unabate this docket for further processing.
