COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, files this Status Report, and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On May 18, 2015, MSEC Enterprises, Inc. (MSEC) filed an application to amend sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 20984 in Montgomery County. On March 16, 2017, Order No. 10 was issued, granting Staff's request to continue the abatement until April 14, 2017, at which point the parties are required to file a joint status report or a joint motion to unabate this docket for further processing.

II. STATUS REPORT

Staff and MSEC are currently discussing additional information that is needed for Staff to complete its evaluation of the application. Staff requests that the proceeding continue to be abated for an additional 30 days, until May 15, 2017, at which point the parties will file a joint status report or a joint motion to unabate this docket for further processing.
