COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, files this Joint Status Report, and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On May 18, 2015, MSEC Enterprises, Inc. (MSEC) filed an application to amend sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 20984 in Montgomery County. On April 17, 2017, Order No. 11 was issued, granting the parties request to continue the abatement until May 15, 2017, at which point the parties are required to file a joint status report or a joint motion to unabate this docket for further processing.

II. STATUS REPORT

Staff and MSEC are continuing to discuss additional information that is needed for Staff to complete its evaluation of the application.
