**JOINT STATUS REPORT AND MOTION
TO LIFT ABATEMENT**

COMES NOW, MSEC Enterprises, Inc. ("MSEC") and Public Utility Commission ("Commission") Staff, and file this Joint Status Report and Motion to Lift Abatement, in compliance with Order No. 12.¹

During the period that this matter has been abated, MSEC and Staff have had productive discussions regarding outstanding issues to be determined in this matter. In order to update the information in the Application and clarify the rates that will be applicable to the proposed service area being requested in the Application that is the subject of this docket, MSEC is filing revisions to its Application as a separate filing in this docket.

The parties respectfully request that the Administrative Law Judge unabate this proceeding, and allow Commission Staff a period of thirty (30) days to review the sufficiency of the filed revisions to the Application. At the end of that thirty (30) day period, the parties will file a proposed procedural schedule that will govern the remainder of the case going forward. MSEC is authorized to represent that Commission Staff joins in this motion.

WHEREFORE PREMISES CONSIDERED, MSEC respectfully requests that this docket be unabated to allow for further processing as provided herein.


