**DEEMING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,
ADDRESSING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

I. Application

On May 18, 2015, MSEC Enterprises, Inc. (Applicant) filed an application to amend sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 20984 in Montgomery County. On July 14, 2015, Applicant filed, in response to identified deficiencies, supplemental information to cure the deficiencies identified by Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff.

II. Administrative Completeness

On August 17, 2015, Commission Staff filed additional comments on the sufficiency of the application, as amended. Commission Staff found Applicant's application, as amended, sufficient for further review. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Applicant's application, as amended, administratively complete.

III. Notice

Commission Staff recommended that Applicant proceed with notice as described in Commission Staff's August 17, 2015 filing and the attached memorandum of Fred Bednarski and Komal Patel of the Commission's Water Utilities Division, using the forms attached to Commission Staff's memorandum.

Consistent with Staff's recommendation, Applicant shall provide notice as described using the forms attached to its August 17, 2015 filing. Applicant shall file a copy of the actual notice sent and file affidavits evidencing proof of notice by the deadline set forth below.


IV. Procedural Schedule

The following procedural schedule shall apply:

Event	Date
Deadline for Applicant to file affidavits of proof of notice and publication	Within 30 days of the date of notice and 30 days of the last publication date
Deadline for intervention; deadline for intervenors to file comments or request a hearing on the merits	Within 30 days of mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later ¹
Deadline for Commission Staff to propose an additional procedural schedule, request a hearing, or file a final recommendation	October 19, 2015
