Final Order, P.U.C. Docket No. 44809; Application of Quadvest, LP for a

Rate/Tariff Change

If the Commission decides to adopt the proposed order in this docket, I recommend the following changes:

- 1) Footnote 1 in the proposed order, as it appears at the bottom of page 5 of the order, should become finding of fact 34A.
- 2) Footnote 2 in the proposed order should be deleted.
- 3) Footnote 3 in the proposed order should be deleted.
- 4) Ordering paragraph 4, as it appears on pages 6-7 of the proposed order, should be deleted and replaced with the following ordering paragraph:
 - 4. Consistent with the agreement, Quadvest is authorized to collect the difference between the correct groundwater pass-through fee and the incorrect pass-through fee that was included in Quadvest's interim tariff. This difference should be collected over a period of time equal to the period during which the pass-through fee was under-collected.
- 5) The following finding of fact should be added:
 - 39. This order will affect approximately 41 water systems operated by Quadvest. For most of these systems, the rates ordered by the Commission in this order will not be increased over the rates in place at the time of Qaudvest's application. However, for the following systems the ordered rates will represent an increase: Decker Oaks, Bayer Utility (Old Town Spring), Shaw Acres, and Caddo Village.
