



ORDER NO. 4 SECOND NOTICE FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

On August 11 and August 20, 2015, in response to Order No. 3, Sharon Water Supply Corporation (Sharon WSC) amended its application to cure deficiencies identified by Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff.

I. Staff Recommendation on Administrative Completeness of the Amended Application and Notice

On September 17, 2015, Commission Staff commented on the amended application. Commission Staff has determined that the application is still deficient and not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's September 17, 2015 filing and the attached memorandum of Debbie Reyes Tamayo, Tracy Harbour, and Fred Bednarski of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

Applicant should not send out notice to affected parties until these discrepancies are corrected.

II. Finding Amended Application Incomplete and Deficient, Providing Opportunity to Cure

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Sharon WSC's application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before October 16, 2015, Applicant shall amend

its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **November 16, 2015**, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule.
