**ORDER NO. 6
FOURTH NOTICE FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE
AND DEFICIENT**

On January 14, 2016, Commission Staff recommended that the application of Sharon Water Supply Corporation (Sharon WSC) is still deficient and not administratively complete as specifically described in Commission Staff's January 14, 2016 filing and the attached memorandum of Debbie Reyes and Tracy Harbor of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division.

Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission. Applicant should not send out notice to affected parties until these discrepancies are corrected.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Sharon WSC's application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **February 10, 2016**, Applicant shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.


On or before **March 9, 2016** Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule.
