**ORDER NO. 7**  
**FINDING APPLICATION REMAINS INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's supplemental recommendation that the application of Sharon Water Supply Corporation is still deficient and not administratively complete as specifically described in Commission Staff's March 9, 2016 filing and the attached memorandum of Debbie Reyes and Tracy Harbor of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division.

Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission. Sharon WSC should not send out notice to affected parties until these discrepancies are corrected.


Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Sharon WSC's application remains administratively incomplete and deficient due to mapping deficiencies. On or before **April 10, 2016**, Applicant shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **May 10, 2016** Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule.
