COMMISSION STAFF'S CLARIFICATION ON SERVICE AREA

Although the original application listed an acreage of 23,534 with 50 current customers, Staff concluded based on the information provided that these numbers should be adjusted to an acreage of 21,342 with 0 current customers. These revised figures were recommended by Staff to be included in the notice issued, and were actually noticed in this way as shown in the proof of notice documents submitted by Sharon Water Supply Corporation on November 22, 2016 and January 5, 2017. In Staff's final recommendation, the Background section incorrectly still listed the original figures, while the final memorandum listed the revised figures. Staff and Sharon Water Supply Corporation have conferred this week and agree that the revised 21,342 acreage with 0 current customers is correct.

If the ALJ has further questions or needs further clarification, Staff is available to assist.


